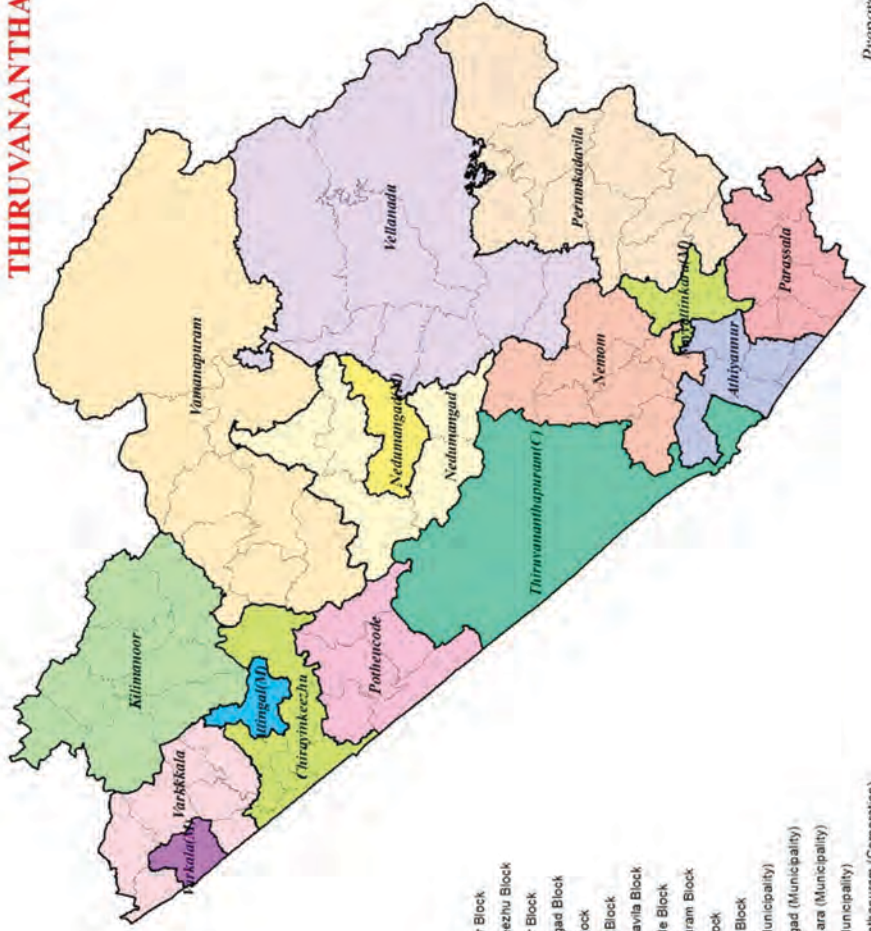

1. GENERAL

Thiruvananthapuram (or Trivandrum) is the capital of the southern Indian state of Kerala. It is situated along the Arabian sea with isolated hills on a coastal plain. The former name of the city-Trivandrum, adopted in early 21st century, was given by the British and is a contraction of Thiruvananthapuram. The district covers an area of 2,192 square kilometers (541,655 acres), 5.63% of state area.

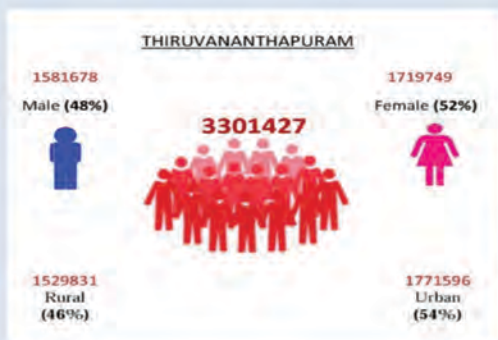

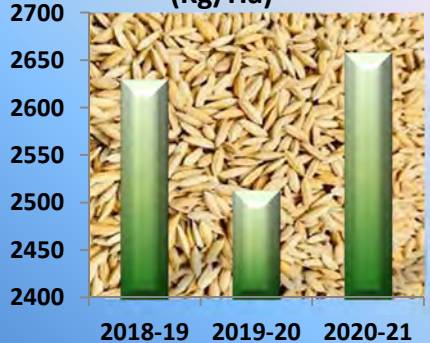

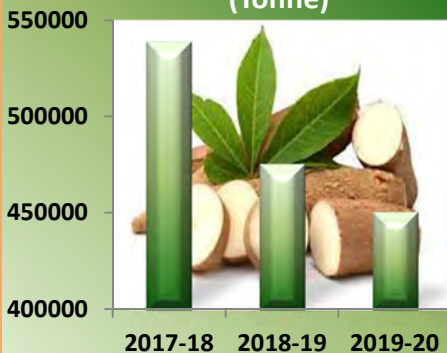
Paddy Production TVM. (Tonne)



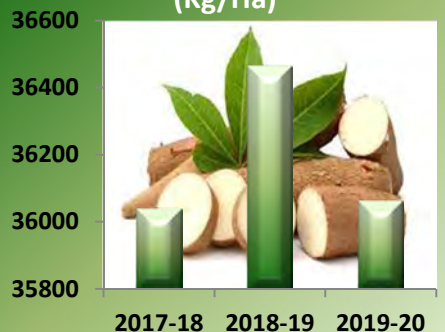
Paddy Productivity TVM. (Kg/Ha)

4. AGRICULTURE

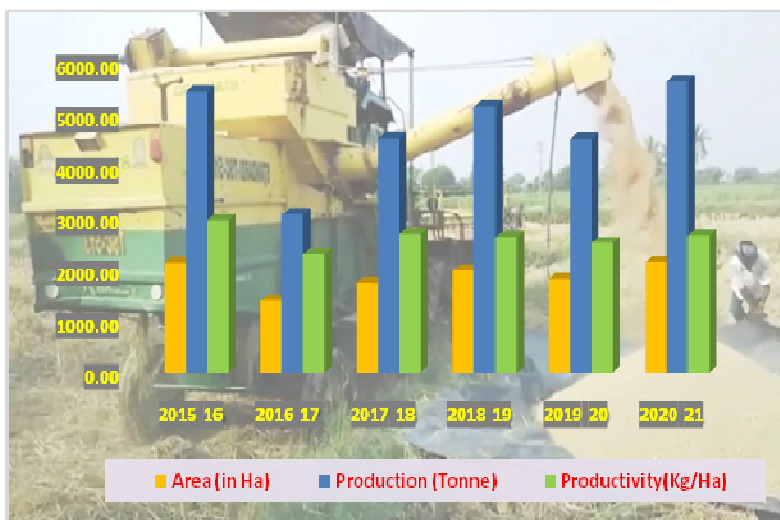

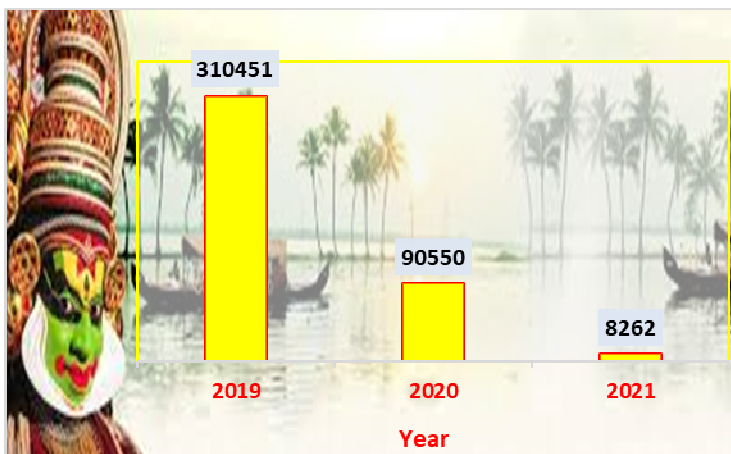

19.STATE INCOME

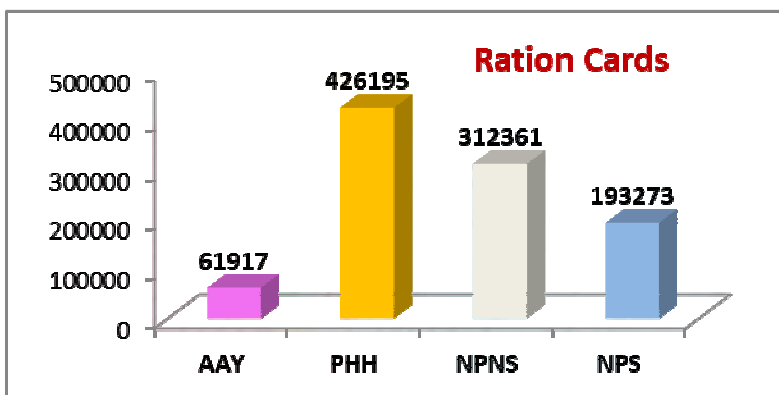


20. PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM

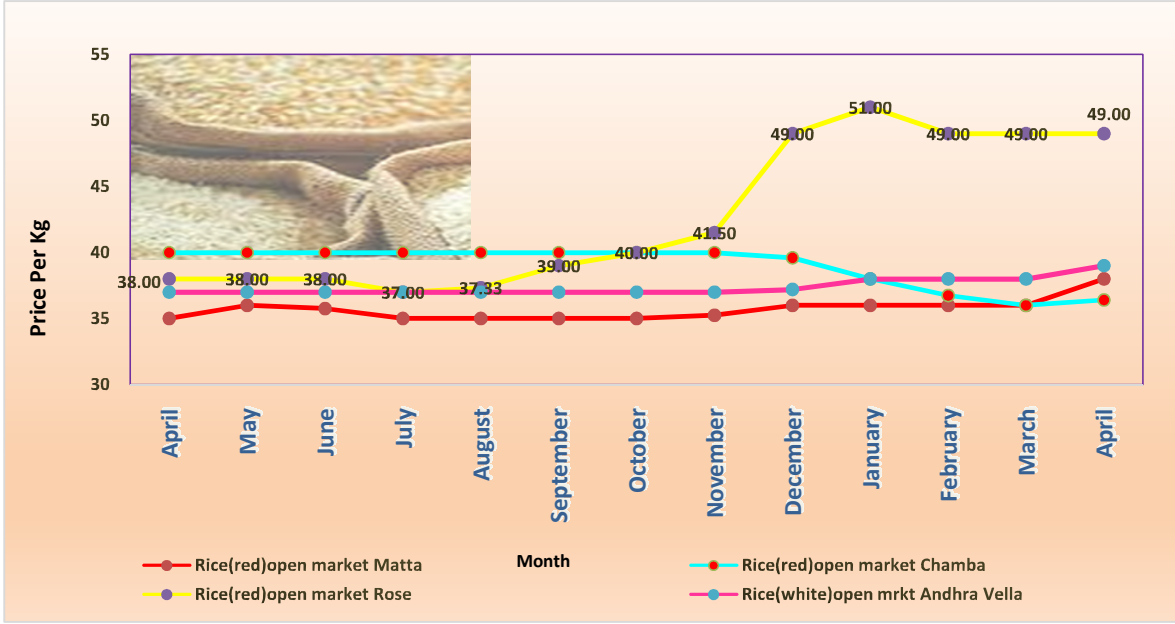

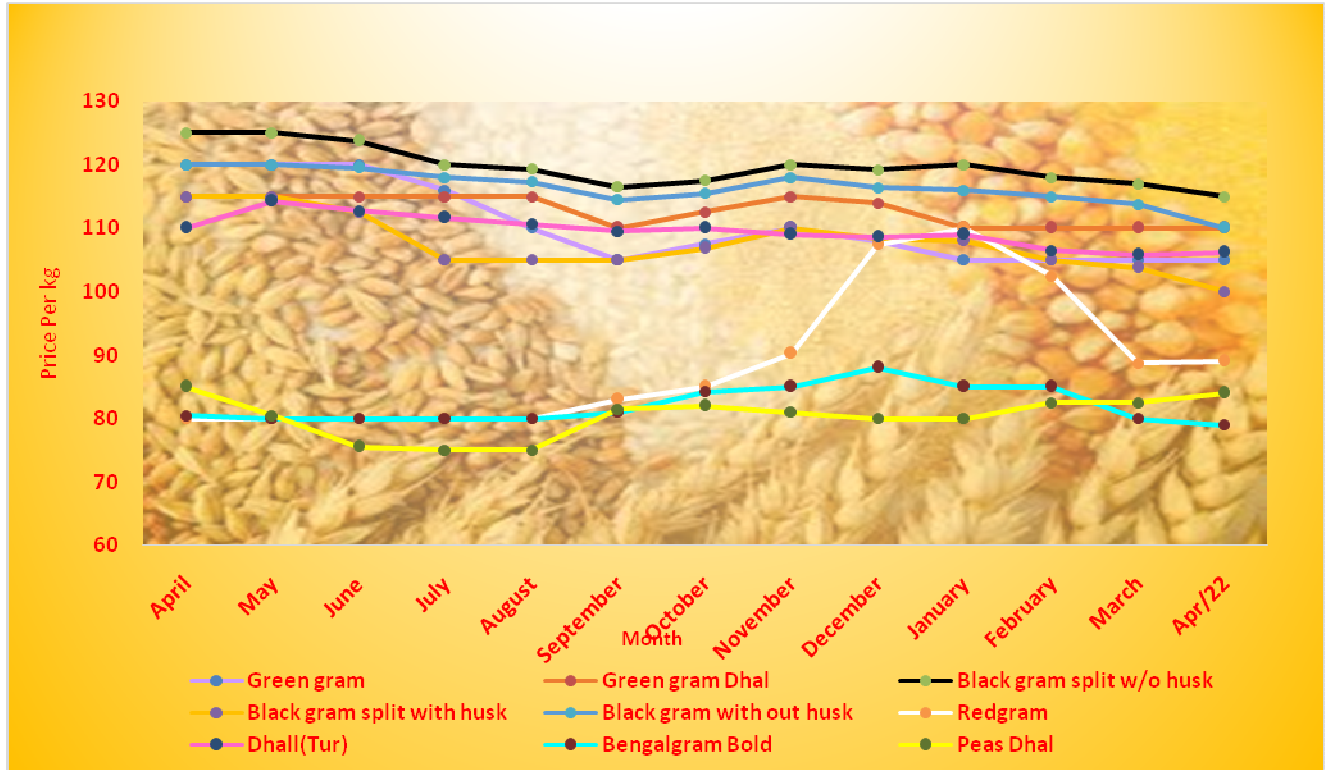

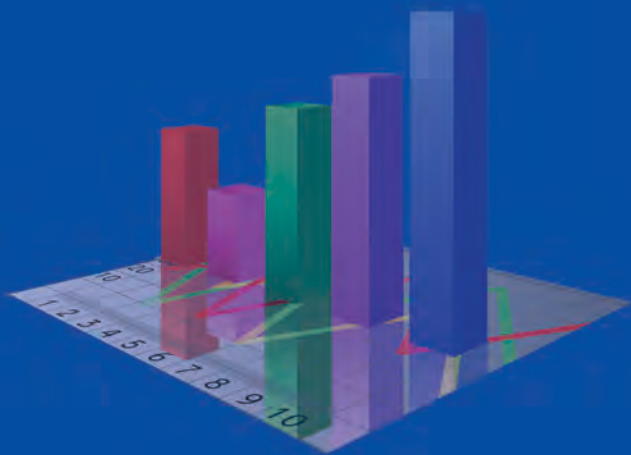
