ORDER

The Bureau of Economics & Statistics was established in the present form with effect from 1-8-1963 by the integration of the former Statistics Department and the Bureau of Economics Studies. Since then the Department has expanded its work covering a wide area of economic activation. The formulation of Year Plans, Perspective Planning, work preparatory of the evaluation of future Plans, the evaluation of developmental projects, studies in demography, compilation of Vital Statistics, complete area enumeration and a large number of sample surveys have led to heavy pressure of work by way of supervision research and analysis by the Additional Director and the Director. The implementation of large number of Plan Schemes and establishment work covering about 1000 employees in the Bureau have contributed to a considerable increase in the routine work of Administration. The Director had, therefore requested for the creation of the post of an Administrative Officer.

2. Government consider that the Director and Additional Director who are technical officers should not be burdened with routine administrative work and that they should concentrate attention on work of a technical nature. To enable this, sanction is accorded for the creation of a post of Administrative Officer to the Director, BES on a scale of pay of Rs.550-800 with immediate effect. The post of Administrative Officer will be an addition to the cadre of Assistant Secretaries in the Administrative Secretariat.

3. The expenditure will be met from the provision under '39-b(ii) Statistical Bureau'.

4. The Administrative Officer will be delegated powers as in the Appendix to this order.
