S. R. O. No. 201/2009.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Kerala Public Services Act, 1968 (19 of 1968), and in supersession of all the existing Special Rules on the subject, the Government of Kerala hereby make the following Special Rules for the Kerala Statistics and Economics Service, namely:—

RULES

1. *Short title and Commencement.*—(1) These rules may be called the Kerala Statistics and Economics Service Special Rules, 2009.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

2. *Constitution.*—The service shall consist of the following categories of officers, namely:—

Note:—(1) Research Assistant/Statistical Inspector/ Computer Supervisor/ Extension Officer (Planning & Monitoring) having Post Graduate Degree can either choose appointment by transfer to the cadre of Research Officer or to the cadre of Taluk Statistical Officer on the basis of their option. Before choosing every person has to file an option. The option once filed shall be final and no other choice shall be allowed.

(2) Appointment by promotion or by transfer except to category I shall be made from select list of eligible officers prepared on the basis of merit and ability; seniority being considered only where merit and ability are approximately equal.

5. Appointing Authority.—The appointing authority in respect of categories 1 to 7 shall be the Government. The appointing authority for categories 8 and 9 shall be the Director.

6. *Probation.*—(a) Every person appointed to any of the categories shall from the date on which he/she joins duty, be on probation,—

(i) if appointed direct or by transfer (where direct recruitment is resorted to) for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years and

(ii) if appointed by promotion or transfer (where direct recruitment is not resorted to) for a total period of one year on duty within a continuous period of two years.

(b) Every person appointed by direct recruitment to category 7—Research Officer shall during the period of probation undergo Six months field duty in the District Officers (Economics and Statistics):

Provided that the provision in sub-rule (b) shall not be applicable to the persons who are appointed to category 7 on or before the date of commencement of these rules.

7. *Reservation of Appointment.*—The rules relating to reservation of appointments contained in Rules 14 to 17 of Part II of the Kerala State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1958 shall apply to appointment to the service by direct recruitment.

8. *Test.*—Every probationer appointed direct to categories 1, 2, 3, 4a, 5 & 7 shall within the period of probation pass the Account Test for Executive Officers or Account Test (Lower or Higher) if he has not already passed the test.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the Notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

Special Rules for the Kerala Statistics and Economics Service were issued in 1967 as per G. O. (P) No. 82/67/PD dated 3-3-1967. Since then a large number of amendments were made to the various provisions in the Rules. Some of the categories have been deleted and some others newly added. The Director of Economics and Statistics has proposed some amendments to some of the provisions. In order to incorporate the amendments and also for making further amendments wherever necessary, it is decided to issue the Special Rules afresh in supersession of all the rules on the subject.

This notification is intended to achieve the above object.
