PREFACE

Price collection is one of the major items of work undertaken by the Department of Economics and Statistics. The importance and usefulness of the information pertaining to the price movements has much significance. This Department has been collecting different types of prices viz. Farm price, Market price, etc. (both Wholesale and Retail). These prices are being widely used for various purposes such as for the preparation of Indices, to provide compensation to Farmers and for tendering consumable articles for Govt. Institutions. Among the Retail prices, the statement of daily prices of fifty essential commodities being collected on daily basis from District Headquarters assume significance, because it is being forwarded daily to the office of the Chief Minister and Minister of Food and Civil Supplies, Minister for Agriculture, Chief Secretary, Food and civil Supplies Secretary, Planning secretary, Department of Civil supplies, Reserve Bank of India, Consumer fed etc. In addition to the daily prices, weekly prices are also being collected every Friday.

From January 2004 onwards a publication titled "PRICE BULLETIN" is being prepared and published monthly incorporating the Retail prices of main essential commodities under 8 major groups. Group wise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representations. These prices are being collected from the market by the Price collectors and supervised by district level Officers

This publication is being prepared and published by Prices Division. I appreciate the work done by Sri. Rajendran Nair. S (Assistant Director), Smt. Shamju.B.K (Research Officer), Sri. Syam.S (Statistical Assistant Grade-I) under the guidance of Sri. Vinodan T P, Additional Director (Prices) for bringing out such a publication.

<u>REVIEW ON RETAIL PRICES OF ESSENTIAL COMMODITIES</u> October- 2023

INTRODUCTION

This bulletin reflects the average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of October 2023. A mixed trend has been seen in the retail prices under report when compared with that of the last months as well as the corresponding month of previous year. Statement showing the monthly average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of October of the previous year 2022, previous month September 2023 and current month of October 2023 along with the percentage of variation over the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year are included in this report. GroupWise analysis has been made with reference to the current month, the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representation.

1. RICE

Comparison of State Average Retail Price of different varieties of Rice

During the month a marginal increasing trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of Rice varieties when compared with the prices of the previous month but a mixed trend was observed when compared with the corresponding month of the previous year.


The State Average Retail Price of Red-Matta increased by 0.27% and Andhra-Vella increased by 0.17% only, but there was no change in the price of Red - Chamba when compared with the prices of the previous month. When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the State Average Retail Price of Red-Matta and Red-Chamba increased by 5.33% and 4.3% respectively while notable decrease was seen in the price of Andhra-Vella (2.74%).

2. PULSES

Comparison of State Average Retail Price of Pulses


During the month an increasing trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of Pulses when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of previous month notable increase was seen in the price of Peas Dhall (3.81%), Dhall (Tur) (2.77%), Bengal Gram Bold (2.77%), Black Gram split without husk (2.65%), Bengal Gram small (1.59%) and Black Gram split with husk (1.11%), but all other items have only marginal variations.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the State Average Retail Price of pulses showed an increasing trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Dhall (Tur) (41.35%), Green gram (23.96%), Bengal Gram Bold (21.36%), Red Gram (20.71%), Green Gram Dhall (13.86%), Black Gram split without husk (13.09%), Bengal Gram small (11.33%), Black Gram split with husk (9.73%) and Peas Dhall (5.39%).

3. OTHER FOOD ITEMS

Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Other Food items.

During the month an increasing trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of Other Food items when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of previous month notable increase was seen in Egg Hen's (White lagon) (7.5%) and Baby Food Amul (5.14%) but all other items have only marginal variations when compared with the prices of the previous month.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the State Average Retail Price of Other Food items showed an increasing trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Coffee Powder (Brook Bond Gr. Label) (19.78%), Milk (Cow's) (13.05%), Egg Hen's (White lagon) (11.24%), Baby Food Amul (7.78%), Sugar (O.M) (6.01%) and Mutton without bones (3.95%).

4. OIL AND OILSEEDS

Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Oil and Oilseeds.

During the month a mixed trend was seen in the State Average Retail Price of Oil and Oil seeds when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of previous month a mixed trend was observed. Notable increase was seen in the price of Coconut without husk (7.38%) and Coconut oil (1.85%) while notable decrease was seen in the price of Refined oil (Postman) (2.14%) and Gingelly oil (1.92%).


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the State Average Retail Price of Oil and Oil seeds also showed a mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Coconut without husk (7.81%) and Coconut oil (1.53%) while notable decrease was seen in the price of Refined oil (Postman) (27.38%) and Gingelly oil (2.1%).

5. SPICES AND CONDIMENTS

Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Spices and Condiments.

During the month an increasing trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of Spices and Condiments when compared with the price of the previous month and showed a mixed trend when compared with the price of corresponding month of the previous year.


Notable increase was seen in the price of Onion small (31.56%), Coriander (2.64%), Garlic (2.16%), Tamarind (1.23%) and Cumin seed (1.17%) but all other items have only marginal variations when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the price of the corresponding month of the previous year, the State Average Retail Price of Spices and Condiments showed mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Garlic (147.99%), Cumin seed (125.48%), Onion small (10.08%), Turmeric (6.27%), Methy (1.14%) and Mustard (1.09%) while notable decrease was seen in the price of Coriander (24.17%) and Chillies dry (7.53%).

6. TUBERS

Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Tubers

During the month a mixed trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of Tubers when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the price of the previous month, the State Average Retail Price of Chenai and Potato were increased by 9.7% and 8.77% repectively while Colocassia and Tapioca Raw decreased by 5.58% and 3.04% respectively.


Mixed trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of Tubers when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year. Notable increase was seen in the prices of Chenai (69.65%) and Colocassia (6.41%) while Tapioca and Potato were decreased by 20.9% and 10.79% respectively.

7. VEGETABLES

Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Vegetables.

During the month a mixed trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of vegetables when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of the previous month, the State Average Retail Prices of vegetables showed a mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Onion (74.23%), Cucumber (56.48%), Ladies Finger (37.66%), Bitter gourd (19.42%), Brinjal (11.5%), Tomato (11.01%), Cabbage (8.26%), Snake gourd (4.98%) and Pumpkin (4.46%) while notable decrease was seen in the price of Banana green (19.39%), Chilies green (7.82%) and Plantain green (7.05%).


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, the State Average Retail Prices of vegetables showed mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Onion big (80.54%), Ladies Finger (18.57%), Snake gourd (10.69%) and Cucumber (8.77%) while notable decrease was seen in the price of Tomato (32.62%), Cabbage (26.14%), Pumpkin (24.25%), Banana green (21.46%), Ash gourd (19.35%), Plantain green (16%), Chilies green (12.22%), Bitter gourd (11.73%) and Brinjal (9.04%).

8. MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS



During the month a mixed trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of this group when compared with the prices of the previous month and an increasing trend when compared with the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of the previous month a mixed trend was observed. Notable increase was seen in the price of Cement-Sanker (Old Paper Bag) (3.6%), Paper (2.42%), Torch Battery (Eveready) (2.21%), Firewood (Local split) (1.61%) and Electric Bulb (Philips) (1.1%), while notable decrease was seen in the prices of Washing Soda (1.08%) only but all the remaining items in this group showed no variations.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the State Average Retail Price of this group showed an increasing trend except Cement-Sanker (Old Paper Bag) (8.7%). Notable increase was seen in the price of Torch Battery (Eveready) (15.94%), Paper (12.09%), Washing Soda (9.69%), Tooth paste(Colgate) (8.35%), Crocin (5.69%), Electric Bulb (Philips) (5.03%), Razor Blade (Topaz) (4.97%), Tobacco (4.79%), Toilet Soap Lux (3.51%), Firewood (Local split) (2.6%) and Mundu (Mull) (2.55%).
