### **PREFACE**

Economics and Statistics department is the Nodal Agency for the collection, compilation and dissemination of price statistics in the state. Department is collecting various types of prices from various centers in the district. Price data prepared by the department is used by various central and state government departments and agencies such as Civil Supplies Department, Forest Department, Reserve Bank of India, Spices Board, Supply co, KSEB etc.

Department is collecting Retail prices of 50 essential commodities and 28 additional items from each district headquarters and consolidate at directorate. Prices of fruits and vegetables and 20 other items are also collected weekly from district headquarters. Analysis of prices thus collected are being done at directorate and daily and weekly reports are sent to the offices of Chief Minister, Minister of Food and Civil Supplies, Minister for Agriculture, Chief Secretary, Food and civil Supplies Secretary, Planning secretary etc.

From January 2004 onwards a publication titled "PRICE BULLETIN" is being prepared and published monthly incorporating the Retail prices of main essential commodities under 8 major groups. Group wise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representations. These prices are being collected from the market by the Price collectors and supervised by district level Officers

This publication, "PRICE BULLETIN DECEMBER 2023" is being prepared and published by Prices Division in the Directorate. I appreciate the work done by Sri. Rajendran Nair S. (Assistant Director), Smt. Shamju B.K. (Research Officer), Sri. Syam S. (Statistical Assistant Grade-I) under the guidance of Sri. Vinodan T. P., Additional Director (Prices) for bringing out such a publication.

## **INTRODUCTION**

This bulletin reflects the average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of December 2023. A mixed trend has been seen in the retail prices under report when compared with that of the last months as well as the corresponding month of previous year. Statement showing the monthly average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of December of the previous year 2022, previous month November 2023 and current month of December 2023 along with the percentage of variation over the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year are included in this report. Group Wise analysis has been made with reference to the current month, the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representation.

### Comparison of State Average Retail Price of different varieties of Rice

During the month a decreasing trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of Rice varieties when compared with the prices of the previous month but a mixed trend was observed when compared with the corresponding month of the previous year.

The State Average Retail Price of Red- Chamba and Red-Matta decreased by 5.15% and 1.23% respectively, but the change in the price of Andra Vella is marginal when compared with the prices of the previous month. When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the State Average Retail Price of Andra Vella and Red- Chamba decreased by 2.85% and 1.08% respectively while notable increase was seen in the price of Red-Matta (3.49%).



### 2. PULSES

### **Comparison of State Average Retail Price of Pulses**

During the month a mixed trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of Pulses when compared with the prices of the previous month and showed an increasing trend when compared with the price of corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of previous month notable increase was seen in the price of Black Gram split without husk (1.84%), Peas Dhall (1.28%) and Black Gram split with husk (1.18%) while notable decrease was seen in the price of Red Gram (4.03%) and Dhall (Tur) (2.3%) but all other items have only marginal variations.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the State Average Retail Price of pulses showed an increasing trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Dhall (Tur) (39.2%), Green gram (27.72%), Red Gram (22.55%), Bengal Gram Bold (19.61%), Black Gram split without husk (17.06%), Black Gram split with husk (17%), Bengal Gram small (15.71%), Peas Dhall (14.9%) and Green Gram Dhall (12.83%).

### 3. OTHER FOOD ITEMS

### Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Other Food items.

During the month an increasing trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of Other Food items when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of previous month notable increase was seen in Egg Hen's (White lagon) (5.6%), Coffee Powder (Brook Bond Gr. Label) (2.87%) and Mutton without bones (1.27%) but all other items have only marginal variations when compared with the prices of the previous month.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the State Average Retail Price of Other Food items showed an increasing trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Coffee Powder (Brook Bond Gr. Label) (21.61%), Egg Hen's (White lagon) (10.84%), Sugar (O.M) (7.38%), Mutton without bones (5.26%) and Baby Food Amul (1.35%).

### 4. OIL AND OILSEEDS

### Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Oil and Oilseeds.

During the month a mixed trend was seen in the State Average Retail Price of Oil and Oil seeds when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of previous month a mixed trend was observed. Notable decrease was seen in the price of Coconut without husk (1.27%) only, but all other items have only marginal variations.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the State Average Retail Price of Oil and Oil seeds also showed a mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Coconut without husk (12.12%) and Coconut oil (1.56%) while notable decrease was seen in the price of Refined oil (Postman) (27.13%) and Gingelly oil (5.77%).

### **5. SPICES AND CONDIMENTS**

### Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Spices and Condiments.

During the month a mixed trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of Spices and Condiments when compared with the price of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

Notable increase was seen in the price of Garlic (23.93%), Coriander (1.94%) and Turmeric (1.92%) while notable decrease was seen in the price of Onion small (23.26%), Cumin seed (5.6%), Chillies dry (2.22%) and Methy (1.04%) but all other items have only marginal variations when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the price of the corresponding month of the previous year, the State Average Retail Price of Spices and Condiments showed a mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Garlic (221.06%), Cumin seed (101.92%), Turmeric (9.62%) and Methy (1.14%) while notable decrease was seen in the price of Onion small (25.54%), Coriander (20.82%) and Chillies dry (11.43%).



### 6. TUBERS

### **Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Tubers**

During the month a decreasing trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of Tubers when compared with the prices of the previous month and showed a mixed trend when compared with the price of corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the price of the previous month, the State Average Retail Price of Chenai and Potato were decreased by 7.5% and 3.46% respectively but all other items have only marginal variations.


Mixed trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of Tubers when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year. Notable increase was seen in the prices of Chenai (57.49%) only while Potato and Tapioca Raw were decreased by 12.04% and 8.72% respectively.

### 7. VEGETABLES

### Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Vegetables.

During the month a mixed trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of vegetables when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of the previous month, the State Average Retail Prices of vegetables showed a mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Brinjal (51.42%), Chilies green (33.8%), Pumpkin (14.85%), Ash gourd (12.4%), Ladies Finger (3.18%) and Cabbage (1.6%) while notable decrease was seen in the price of Onion big (36.37%), Snake gourd (18.49%), Tomato (14.21%), Cucumber (11.21%), Banana green (9.98%) and Bitter gourd (5.01%) but all other items have only marginal variations.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, the State Average Retail Prices of vegetables showed a mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Tomato (51.19%), Brinjal (50.29%), Ladies Finger (30.07%), Onion big (20.36%), Bitter gourd (15.94%), Snake gourd (10.38%), Pumpkin (9.2%), Chilies green (8.06%) and Ash gourd (4.3%) while notable decrease was seen in the price of Banana green (23.54%), Plantain green (8.64%) and Cucumber (7.62%).

### 8. MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

### Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of miscellaneous items

During the month a mixed trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of this group when compared with the prices of the previous month and an increasing trend when compared with the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of the previous month a mixed trend was observed. Notable increase was seen in the price of Torch Battery (Eveready) (3.23%), Tooth paste(Colgate) (1.39%) and Paper (1.33%). Notable decrease was seen in the price of Cement-Sanker (Old Paper Bag) (3.41%) only, but all the remaining items in this group showed only marginal variations.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the State Average Retail Price of this group showed an increasing trend except Cement-Sanker (Old Paper Bag) (4.51%). Notable increase was seen in the price of Torch Battery (Eveready) (12.99%), Washing Soda (9.03%), Paper (8.52%), Tooth paste(Colgate) (7.72%), Crocin (5.69%), Tobacco (5.66%), Electric Bulb (Philips) (5.03%), Razor Blade (Topaz) (3.42%) and Mundu (Mull) (1.81%).
