PREFACE

Price collection is one of the major items of work undertaken by the Department of Economics and Statistics. The importance and usefulness of the information pertaining to the price movements has much significance. This Department has been collecting different types of prices viz. Farm price, Market price, etc. (both Wholesale and Retail). These prices are being widely used for various purposes such as for the preparation of Indices, to provide compensation to Farmers and for tendering consumable articles for Govt. Institutions. Among the Retail prices, the statement of daily prices of fifty essential commodities being collected on daily basis from District Headquarters assume significance, because it is being forwarded daily to the office of the Chief Minister and Minister of Food and Civil Supplies, Minister for Agriculture, Chief Secretary, Food and civil Supplies Secretary, Planning secretary, Department of Civil supplies, Reserve Bank of India, Consumerfed etc. In addition to the daily prices, weekly prices are also being collected every Friday.

From January 2004 onwards a publication titled "PRICE BULLETIN" is being prepared and published monthly incorporating the Retail prices of main essential commodities under 8 major groups. Group wise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representations.

This publication is being prepared and published by Prices Division. I appreciate the work done by Sri.Damodaran.K, Additional Director (Prices). Sri. Sivalal. S (Assistant Director) Sri. Sooraj Cheruthottathil (Statistical Assistant Grade-I) and all the Price Reporters and Price Supervisors in the Districts for preparing such a worthy publication.

REVIEW ON RETAIL PRICES OF ESSENTIAL COMMODITIES

FEBRUARY 2021

INTRODUCTION

This bulletin reflects the average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of February 2021. A mixed trend has been seen in the retail prices under report when compared with that of the last months as well as the corresponding month of previous year. Statement showing the monthly average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of February of the previous year 2020, previous month January 2021 and current month of February 2021 along with the percentage of variation over the previous month and the current month of the previous year are included in this report. Group Wise analysis has been made with reference to the current month, the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representation.

1. RICE

Comparison of state average Retail prices of different varieties of Rice

During the month a marginal mixed trend was observed in the state average retail price of Rice varieties when compared with the prices of the previous month, as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

The State average retail price of Red Matta decreased by 0.16%, White Andhra Vella increased by 0.28% while that of Red Chamba remains unchanged when compared with the prices of the previous month.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, the state average retail prices of Red Matta and White Andra Vella decreased by 9.78~% and 3.83~%, while that of Red Chamba increased by 1.27%.

2. PULSES

Comparison of state average Retail prices of Pulses.

During the month a mixed trend was observed in the state average retail price of Pulses when compared with the prices of the previous month, , as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

The State average retail price of all items of Pulses showed an upward trend up to 3.63% when compared with the prices of the previous month except Bengalgram bold, Bengalgram small and Peas Dhall.


When compared with the price of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of all items of pulses except Black gram split w/o husk and Bengalgram small showed an upward trend up to 14.11%. Notable increase was seen in the price of Dhal Tur(14.11%), Peas dhal (12.58%), Blackgram split with husk (8.22%), Greengram (7.53%) when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year.

3. OTHER FOOD ITEMS

Comparison of state average Retail prices of other food items.

During the month a mixed trend was observed in the state average retail price of Other food items when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of previous month the prices of Egg (White Lagon) decreased by 3.72% while all the remaining item in this group showed a marginal variation.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of Mutton with bones increased by 9.95% and Egg(Hens)White Lagon 5.75% while, the prices of all other items showed a marginal variations .

4. OIL AND OILSEEDS

Comparison of state average Retail prices of Oil and oilseeds.

During the month an increasing trend was observed in the State average retail price of Oil and Oil seeds except the prices of Gingelly Oil and Coconut without Husk when compared with the price of the previous month

The State average retail price of all items of Oil and Oil seeds showed a increasing trend up to 3.41% when compared with the prices of the previous month except Gingelly Oil and Coconut without Husk.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of Refined Oil, Coconut Oil, Groundnut Oil and Coconut without husk increased by 30.28 %,19.05 %, 13.44 % and 10.11 % respectively while the price of Gingelly oil Decreased by 7.99%,

5. SPICES AND CONDIMENTS

Comparison of state Average Retail prices of Spices and Condiments:

Mixed trend was observed in the State average retail price of spices and Condiments when compared with the price of the previous month as well as with the corresponding month of the previous year.

The price of Onion Small showed a huge increase, increased by 46.60% when compared with the price of the previous month. Prices of all the remaining items showed a slight variations.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, Notable increase was seen in the price of Onion Small (114.54%), Tamarind without seed Loose (10.76 %), and Mustard(10.53) %, while notable decrease was seen in the price of Garlic (31.52%) and chillies dry (13.85%).prices of all the remaining items showed a slight variations.

6. TUBERS

Comparison of state Average Retail prices of Tubers

During the month a decreasing trend was observed in the state average retail price of Tubers when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the Corresponding month of the previous year.

The prices of Potato, Coloccassia, Tapioca raw and Elephant Yam, decreased 15.02 %, 4.93%, 3.08 % and 2.47 % respectively when compared with the prices of the previous month.


Decreasing trend was observed in the retail prices of Tubers when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year. Notable decrease was seen in the price of Coloccassia (20.58 %) and Tapioca raw (19.25 %).

7. VEGETABLES

Comparison of state average Retail prices of Vegetables.

A mixed trend was observed in the State average retail price of vegetables when compared with that of the previous month, as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.


When compared with the prices of the previous month, the state average retail price of all items of vegetables except cabbage, Cucumber and Brinjal showed an upward trend up to 27.55%. Notable increase was seen in the price of Ash gourd (27.55%), Onion Big(26.66%), Tomato(21.01%).

When compared with the corresponding month of the previous year, the state average retail price of all items of vegetables except cabbage, Pumpkin and Plantain Green showed an upward trend up to 85.61%. Notable increase was seen in the price of Ladys Finger(85.61%), Onion Big (55.42%), Cucumber(52.56%) and Tomato(38.04%), while that of notable decrease was seen in the price Plantain Green (18.24%).

8. MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

Comparison of state Average Retail prices of miscellaneous items

A mixed trend was observed in the State average retail price of miscellaneous items when compared with that of the previous month, as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of the previous month, the state average retail prices of Crocin increased 9.65%, while the state average retail prices of Cement (Sankar) decreased 2.65%, while, the prices of all other items showed a marginal variations.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous Year the state average retail price of all items except electric bulb (Philips) and mundu mull showed an upward trend up to 25%. Notable increase was seen in the price of Crocin (25%), Torch Battery (Eveready)(14.24%), Tobacco(12.56%), Toilet Soap-Lux(8.52%).
