

PREFACE

Price collection is one of the major items of work undertaken by the Department of Economics and Statistics. The importance and usefulness of the information pertaining to the price movements has much significance. This Department has been collecting different types of prices viz. Farm price, Market price, etc. (both Wholesale and Retail). These prices are being widely used for various purposes such as for the preparation of Indices, to provide compensation to Farmers and for tendering consumable articles for Govt. Institutions. Among the Retail prices, the statement of daily prices of fifty essential commodities being collected on daily basis from District Headquarters assume significance, because it is being forwarded daily to the office of the Chief Minister and Minister of Food and Civil Supplies, Minister for Agriculture, Chief Secretary, Food and civil Supplies Secretary, Planning secretary, Department of Civil supplies, Reserve Bank of India, Consumerfed etc. In addition to the daily prices, weekly prices are also being collected every Friday.

From January 2004 onwards a publication titled "PRICE BULLETIN" is being prepared and published monthly incorporating the Retail prices of main essential commodities under 8 major groups. Group wise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representations.

This publication is being prepared and published by Prices Division. I appreciate the work done by Sri.Sajeevu.P.P, Additional Director (Prices). Smt.Maya.S (Assistant Director), Sri.Raveendran Pillai.R. (Research Officer), Sri.Sooraj Cheruthottathil (Statistical Assistant Grade I) and all the Price Reporters and Price Supervisors in the Districts for preparing such a worthy publication.

REVIEW ON RETAIL PRICES OF ESSENTIAL COMMODITIES

JUNE 2020

INTRODUCTION

This bulletin reflects the average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of June 2020. A mixed trend has been seen in the retail prices under report when compared with that of the last month as well as the corresponding month of previous year. Statement showing the monthly average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of June of the previous year 2019, previous month May 2020 and current month of June 2020 are attached and the percentage of variation over the previous month and the current month of the previous year are attached. GroupWise analysis has been made with reference to the current month, the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representation.

1. RICE

Comparison of state average Retail prices of different varieties of Rice


During the month a decreasing trend was observed in average retail price of Rice varieties except Red Champa when compared with the prices of the previous month, while an increasing trend was observed in the state average retail price of Rice varieties except Red Champa when compared with the corresponding month of the previous year. The State average retail prices of Red Matta and White Andhra Vella decreased by 3.73%, 1.45% respectively, while that of Red Chamba remains unchanged when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail prices of Red Matta and White Andra Vella increased by 4.97 % and 1.88 %, while that of Red Chamba remains unchanged. The following table and diagram represent the prices and percentage of variation over month and year of Rice.

2. PULSES

Comparison of state average Retail prices of Pulses.


During the month a downward trend was observed in the state average retail price of Pulses when compared with the prices of the previous month and an upward trend was observed when compared with the corresponding month of the previous year except that of bengalgram small. The State average retail price of all items of Pulses showed a downward trend when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the price of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of all items of pulses, showed an upward trend up to 35.72%. Notable increase was seen in the price of Greengram (35.72%), Greengram dhal (35.71%). Blackgram split w/o husk (29.38%) ,Blackgram split with husk (27.89%) when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year. 3. OTHER FOOD ITEMS

Comparison of state average Retail prices of other food items.


During the month a Mixed trend was observed in the state average retail price of Other food items when compared with the prices of the previous month and an upward trend was observed in almost all the items except Egg(Hens)white Lagoon when compared with the corresponding month of the previous year. The price of white lagoon increased by 11.36% when compared with the price of previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of Egg(Hens)White Lagoon decreased by 1.41% while, the prices of all other items of other food items increased up to 12.27%. The following table and diagram represent the prices and percentage of variation over month and year of Other food items..

4. OIL AND OILSEEDS

Comparison of state average Retail prices of Oil and oilseeds.


During the month a decreasing trend was observed in the State average retail price of Oil and oil seeds when compared with the price of the previous month while, a mixed trend was observed, when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year. The state average retail price of Oil and Oil seeds decreased upto 4.49% when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of coconut without husk, Refined Oil and Coconut Oil increased by 12.52%,12.31%, and 7.81%, where as Gingelly oil and groundnut oil Decreased by 11.68%,2.49% respectively, when compared with the corresponding month of the previous year. The following table and diagram represents the prices and percentage of variation over month and year, of Oil and oil seeds..

5. SPICES AND CONDIMENTS

Comparison of state Average Retail prices of Spices and Condiments:


During the month a mixed trend was observed in the State average retail price of spices and condiments when compared with the price of the previous month as well as with the corresponding month of the previous year. The state average retail price of Methy and Mustard showed an upward trend while that of all other items showed a downward trend when compared with the price of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of all items of spices and condiments except Onion Small, Corriander and turmeric increased upto 35.91%. Notable increase was seen in the price of Chillies dry (35.91%), Garlic (16.68%) when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year. The following table and diagram represents the prices and percentage of variation over month and year, of Spices and Condiments.

Comparison of state Average Retail prices of Tubers


During the month a Mixed trend was observed in the state average retail price of Tubers when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the Corresponding month of the previous year . The state average retail prices of Chenai and Colocassia increased 5.05% and 1.49% while the prices of other items showed a decreasing trend when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the State average retail price of Potato increased by 31.69%, while that of all other items decreased upto 18.06%. 7. VEGETABLES

Comparison of state average Retail prices of Vegetables.


A mixed trend was observed during the month in the State average retail price of vegetables when compared with that of the previous month while a decreasing trend observed in almost all the items except Ashgourd when compared with the corresponding month of the previous year. The state average retail prices of all items of Vegetables except Lady's finger, Cucumber, Cabbage, Pumpkin, Plantain green and Brinjal increased up to 38.58% when compared with the prices of the previous month. Notable increase was seen in the price of Tomato (38.58%), and Chillies green (12.18%) when compared with the prices of the previous month.

The state average retail price of almost all the vegetables except Ashguard decreased upto 33.09% while that of Ashguard increased by 5.53%, when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year. Notable decrease was showed in the prices of Cabbage (33.09%), Banana green (30.50%), chililes green(26.55%) and Snake guard(25.60%) when compared with the Prices of the corresponding month of the Previous Year.

8. MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

Comparison of state Average Retail prices of miscellaneous items


A mixed trend was observed during the month in the State average retail price of miscellaneous items when compared with that of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year. The state average retail prices of firewood(split), Tobacco, Crocin, Torch battery(Eveready) Toilet soap Lux, Toothpaste – Colgate, Paper, Mundu mull increased upto 5.17%, while the prices of all other items of miscellaneous showed a slight decrease up to 0.97% when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the State average retail price of Mundu mull, Toilet Soap and Electric Bulb(Philips) was decreased upto 16.80%. all other items showed a increasing trend up to 11.93%. Notable decrease was seen in the price of Toilet soap-Lux (16.80%), when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year. The following table and diagram represents the prices and percentage of variation over month and year of Miscellaneous Items.
