PREFACE

Price collection is one of the major items of work undertaken by the Department of Economics and Statistics. The importance and usefulness of the information pertaining to the price movements has much significance. This Department has been collecting different types of prices viz. Farm price, Market price, etc. (both Wholesale and Retail). These prices are being widely used for various purposes such as for the preparation of Indices, to provide compensation to Farmers and for tendering consumable articles for Govt. Institutions. Among the Retail prices, the statement of daily prices of fifty essential commodities being collected on daily basis from District Headquarters assume significance, and it is being forwarded daily to the office of the Chief Minister and Minister of Food and Civil Supplies, Minister for Agriculture, Chief Secretary, Food and civil Supplies Secretary, Planning secretary, Department of Civil supplies, Reserve Bank of India, Consumerfed etc. In addition to the daily prices, weekly prices are also being collected every Friday.

From January 2004 onwards a publication titled "PRICE BULLETIN" is being prepared and published monthly incorporating the Retail prices of main essential commodities under 8 major groups. Group wise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representations.

This publication is being prepared and published by Prices Division. I appreciate the work done by Sri. Damodaran. K, Additional Director (Prices) Sri. Sivalal. S (Assistant Director) Sri. Sooraj Cheruthottathil (Statistical Assistant Grade-I) and all the Price Reporters and Price Supervisors in the Districts for preparing such a worthy publication.

REVIEW ON RETAIL PRICES OF ESSENTIAL COMMODITIES

SEPTEMBER 2020

INTRODUCTION

This bulletin reflects the average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of September 2020. A mixed trend has been seen in the retail prices when compared with that of the last months as well as the corresponding month of previous year. Statement showing the monthly average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of September of the previous year 2019, previous month August 2020 and current month of September 2020 are attached and the percentage of variation over the previous month and the current month of the previous year are Included. GroupWise analysis has been made with reference to the current month, the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representation.

1. RICE

Comparison of state average Retail prices of different varieties of Rice

During the month a decreasing trend was observed in the state average retail price of Rice varieties except Red Champa when compared with the prices of the previous month, as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

The State average retail prices of Red Matta and White Andhra Vella decreased by 0.16%, 0.62% respectively, while that of Red Chamba remains unchanged when compared with the prices of the previous month.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail prices of Red Matta and White Andra Vella decreased by 3.50 % and 0.73 %, while that of Red Chamba increased by 1.27%.

2. PULSES

Comparison of state average Retail prices of Pulses.

During the month a mixed trend was observed in the state average retail price of Pulses when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year. The State average retail price of all items of Pulses showed marginal variations when compared with the prices of the previous month.


When compared with the price of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of all items of pulses showed an upward trend except the price of Red gram and Bengal gram small. Notable increase was seen in the price of Blackgram split w/o husk (23.80%) Blackgram split with husk (22.80%), Greengram dhal (21.71%), Greengram (18.61%), when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year.

3. OTHER FOOD ITEMS

Comparison of state average Retail prices of other food items.

During the month a Mixed trend was observed in the state average retail price of Other food items when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

Only a marginal variations was seen, except the price of Egg white lagoon, that increased by 8.25% when compared with the price of previous month.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of Egg(Hens)White Lagoon increased by 19.93% and Mutton with bones 10.68% while, the prices of all other items showed a marginal variations .

4. OIL AND OILSEEDS

Comparison of state average Retail prices of Oil and oilseeds.

During the month an increasing trend was observed in the State average retail price of Oil and oil seeds except the price of Gingelly oil, when compared with the price of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

The state average retail price of Oil and Oil seeds increased upto 6.66% when compared with the prices of the previous month.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of Refined Oil, Coconut without husk, Coconut Oil and Groundnut Oil increased by 13.18%, 8.93%, 5.25% and 4.52% respectively while the prices of Gingelly oil Decreased by 7.13%, when compared with the corresponding month of the previous year.

5. SPICES AND CONDIMENTS

Comparison of state Average Retail prices of Spices and Condiments:

During the month a mixed trend was observed in the State average retail price of spices and condiments when compared with the price of the previous month as well as with the corresponding month of the previous year.

The state average retail price of Turmeric showed a slight decrease, while that of all other items showed an upward trend upto 20.06%, Notable increase was seen in the prices of Onion small when compared with the price of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of all items of spices and condiments except the price of Garlic and Corriander increased up to 12.34%. Notable increase was seen in the price of Tamarind without seed loose (12.34%), Onion Small (11.90%), and Chillies dry(6.11%) when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year.



6. TUBERS

Comparison of state Average Retail prices of Tubers

During the month a Mixed trend was observed in the state average retail price of Tubers when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the Corresponding month of the previous year .

The state average retail prices of Potato and Tapioca increased by 5.19% and 3.55% while the prices of Coloccassia and Elephant Yam decreased by 4.40% and 4.15% when compared with the prices of the previous month.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the State average retail price of Potato increased by 56.76%, while that of all other items decreased upto 15.47%.

7. VEGETABLES

Comparison of state average Retail prices of Vegetables.

An Increasing trend was observed during the month in the State average retail price of vegetables when compared with that of the previous month, while a mixed trend was observed when compared with the corresponding month of the previous year.


The state average retail prices of all items of Vegetables except Ash guard and Cucumber showed an increasing trend when compared with the prices of the previous month. Notable increase was seen in the price of Onion Big(64.78%,) Tomato (33.45%), Ladies finger(19.79%),banana Green(18.42%) Chillies green(14.58%), Cabbage(11.63%), Brinjal(10.56%) when compared with the prices of the previous month.

Mixed trend was observed when compared with the corresponding month of the previous year. Notable increase was seen in the price of Tomato(74.75%), Ladies finger(41.50%), Chillies Green(23.83%), Pupkin(21.87%) while the prices of Cucumber(31.21%), Onion Big(21.47%), Plantain green((16.36%) decreased when compared with the corresponding month of the previous year.

8. MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

Comparison of state Average Retail prices of miscellaneous items

A mixed trend was observed during the month in the State average retail price of miscellaneous items when compared with that of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

The state average retail prices of firewood(split), Tobacco, Crocin, Elecric Bulb(Philips), Paper, increased upto 1.54%, while the prices of all other items of miscellaneous showed a slight decrease or remain stable when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the State average retail price of Torch battery (Eveready), Tobacco, Crocin, Washing soda, and Cement Sankar was increased upto 13.25%. while the prices of all other items showed a downward trend up to 7.42%. Notable decrease was seen in the price of Toilet soap-Lux (7.42%), when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year.


