

PREFACE

Price collection is one of the major items of work undertaken by the Department of Economics and Statistics. The importance and usefulness of the information pertaining to the price movements has much significance in the context of a growing economy. This Department has been collecting different types of prices viz. Farm price, Market price, etc. (both Wholesale and Retail). These prices are being widely used for various purposes such as for the preparation of Indices, to provide compensation to Farmers and for tendering consumable articles for Govt. Institutions. Among the Retail prices, the statement of daily prices of fifty essential commodities being collected on daily basis from District Headquarters assume significance, because it is being forwarded daily to the office of the Chief Minister and Minister of Food and Civil Supplies, Minister for Agriculture, Chief Secretary, Food and civil Supplies Secretary, Planning secretary, Department of Civil supplies, Reserve Bank of India, Consumerfed etc. In addition to the daily prices, weekly prices are also being collected every Friday.

From January 2004 onwards a publication titled "PRICE BULLETIN" is being prepared and published monthly incorporating the Retail prices of main essential commodities under 8 major groups. Group wise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representations.

This publication is being prepared and published by Prices Division under the supervision of Sri.K.Damodaran, Additional Director (Prices). I appreciate the work done by Smt.Maya.S (Assistant Director), Smt.Sharulatha (Research Officer) Sri.Sooraj Cheruthottathil (Statistical Assistant Grade I) and all the Price Reporters and Price Supervisors in the Districts for preparing such a worthy publication.

Suggestions if any for improving the publication is solicited.

REVIEW ON RETAIL PRICES OF ESSENTIAL COMMODITIES

JULY 2018

INTRODUCTION

This bulletin reflects the average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of July 2018. A mixed trend has been seen in the retail prices under report when compared with that of the last month as well as the corresponding month of previous year. Statement showing the monthly average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of July of the previous year 2017, previous month June 2018 and current month of July 2018 are attached and the percentage of variation over the previous month and the current month of the previous year are attached. GroupWise analysis has been made with reference to the current month, the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representation.

1. RICE

Comparison of state average Retail prices of different varieties of Rice


Due to adequate availability Rice in the market, down trend continued in the price of Rice when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year. The State average retail prices of Red Matta and Andhra Vella showed a slight decrease and Red Chamba remains stable when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail prices of Red Matta and Andhra Vella showed a downward trend up to 7.78%, while the price of Red Chamba increased by about 6% when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year. The following table and diagram represent the prices and percentage of variation over month and year of Rice.

2. PULSES

Comparison of state average Retail prices of Pulses.

During this period a mixed trend was observed in the state average retail price of Pulses when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year. The State average retail the price of Green gram, Red Gram, Bengal Gram Bold and Peas Dhall showed an upward trend up to 5.71% while the price of all other items of pulses showed a marginal decrease up to 1.58% when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the price of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of all items of pulses except Green gram showed a downward trend up to 30.77% when compared with the prices of the previous year. Notable decrease was seen in the price of Blackgram split w/o husk (20.43%) Blackgram split with husk(18.04%), Bengalgram Bold (24.43%) Bengalgram Small (30.77%) and Redgram (14.47%) when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year.


Meanwhile, the announcement of a hike in minimum support price (MSP) for various crops including Pulses is expected to rise the price of pulses in the coming months,

3. OTHER FOOD ITEMS

Comparison of state average Retail prices of other food items.


.Sharp variations are seen in the price of Sugar during this month. The Prices of Egg Hen (White lagoon)also went up sharply. The prices of both the items witnessed a steady gain during this month. Sugar and Egg Hen (White lagoon) gained by about 7.40% and 5.27% respectively.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year a mixed trend was seen in this group. the state average retail price of Sugar go down by about 10% while the price of Egg Hen (White lagoon) and Mutton With Bones rise to 13.63% and 6.80% respectively. The following table and diagram represent the prices and percentage of variation over month and year of other food items.

4. OIL AND OILSEEDS


Comparison of state average Retail prices of Oil and oilseeds.

During this period a mixed trend was seen in the Prices of Oil and Oil seeds. Meanwhile Downtrend continued in the prices of Coconut and Coconut Oil during the month of july. All other items in this group showed a nominal increase when compared with the prices of the previous month. The state average retail price of Coconut without husk and Coconut Oil down by 4.94% and 1.93% respectively, while the price of all other items oil and oil seeds showed an upward trend up to 1.75% when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of all items of Oil and Oil seeds showed an upward trend up to 36.92%. Notable increase was seen in the price of Coconut Oil (36.92%) and Coconut without husk (20.33%) when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year.

5. SPICES AND CONDIMENTS

Comparison of state Average Retail prices of Spices and Condiments:


During this period a remarkable variations are seen the prices of Onion Small, that witnessed a continues upward trend. The State average retail prices of Onion small went up by about 38% during this period. All other items in this group showed a slight up and down variations when compared with the price of the previous month. The price of Cuminseed Mustard, Methy and Turmeric showed an upward trend up to 1.36% while the prices of Corriander, Chillies dry and Garlic showed a downward trend up to 3.10% when compared with the price of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of Chillies dry, Tamarind without seeds loose and Cuminseed showed an upward trend up to 50.35% while the prices of all other items of Spices and Condiments showed a downward trend up to 30.81% when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year. Notable increase was seen in the price of Chillies dry (50.35%) Tamarind without seeds loose (36.34%) and decrease was seen in the price of Onion small (30.81%) and Garlic(29.48%) when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year.

Comparison of state Average Retail prices of Tubers


During the midst of this month the truck strike affected the market Price. An upward trend was observed during the month in the State average retail price of tubers, when compared with the prices of the previous month The state average retail prices of all items of Tubers went up by about 6 % when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the State average retail prices of all items of Tubers \except Potato showed a downward trend up to 31.06%. Notable decrease was seen in the price of Chenai (31.06%), Coloccassia(20.70%) and Tapioca Raw (16.68%) when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year.

7. VEGETABLES

Comparison of state average Retail prices of Vegetables.


During this period the truck strike affected the price of vegetable Items. Most of the Items in this group showed a remarkable increase during this month. Notable increase was seen in the price of Chillies green Cucumber, Onion Big and Ash guard by about 46%. While the prices of Banana Green and Plantain green showed a downward trend up to 7.17% when compared with the prices of the previous month

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year a mixed trend was observed the state average retail price of Vegetables. Notable decrease was seen in the price of Tomato (62.36%), Ladies Finger (22.22%) Cucumber (15.13%), and Plantain green (22.04%), while the prices of Onion Big increased by about 41.48% when compared with the price of the corresponding month of the previous year. The following table and diagram represents the prices and percentage variation over month and year of Vegetables.

Comparison of state Average Retail prices of miscellaneous items


