

PREFACE

Price collection is one of the major items of work undertaken by the Department of Economics and Statistics. The importance and usefulness of the information pertaining to the price movements has much significance in the context of a growing economy. This Department has been collecting different types of prices viz. Farm price, Market price, etc. (both Wholesale and Retail). These prices are being widely used for various purposes such as for the preparation of Indices, to provide compensation to Farmer's and for tendering consumable articles for Govt. Institutions. Among the Retail prices, the daily prices of fifty essential commodities being collected on daily basis from District Headquarters assumes significance, because the same is being forwarded daily to the office of the Chief Minister and Minister of Food and Civil Supplies, Minister for Agriculture, Chief Secretary, Food and civil Supplies Secretary, Planning secretary, Agr.Production Commissioner, Department of Civil supplies, Reserve Bank of India etc. In addition to the daily prices, weekly prices are also being collected every Friday.

From January 2004 onwards a publication titled "PRICE BULLETIN" is being prepared and published monthly incorporating the Retail prices of main essential commodities under 8 major groups. Group wise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representations.

This publication is being prepared and published by Prices Division under the supervision of Sri.T.Gorkey Jose, Additional Director (Prices). I appreciate the work done by Smt.L.Sheeja (Assistant Director), Smt.K.Indira Devi (Research Officer), Sri.Sooraj Cheruthottathil (Statistical Assistant Grade I) and all the Price Reporters and Price Supervisors in the Districts for preparing such a worthy publication.

Suggestions if any for improving the publication is solicited.

REVIEW ON RETAIL PRICES OF ESSENTIAL COMMODITIES

MAY 2014

Introduction

This bulletin reflects the average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of May 2014. An increasing trend has been seen in the retail prices under report when compared with that of the last month as well as the corresponding month of previous year. Statement showing the monthly average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of May of the previous year 2013, previous month April 2014 and current month of May 2014 are attached and the percentage variation over previous month and current month of previous year are attached. GroupWise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representation.

1. RICE


Comparison of state average Retail prices of different varieties of Rice

During this period an upward trend was observed in the retail prices of Rice when compared with the prices of the previous month. A marginal increase is seen in the price of Red Chamba, Red Matta and White Andhra vella when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail prices of Red Chamba and White Andhra vella had increased by 0.59% and 6.84% respectively, while the price of Red Matta had decreased by 9.23 %. The following table and diagrame represents the prices and percentage variation over month and year of Rice.


2. PULSES

Comparison of state average Retail prices of Pulses.

A mixed trend was observed during the month in the State average retail price of pulses when compared with that of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year. The state average retail prices of Greengram, Dhal and Bengalgram Bold showed a negative change up to 1%, while the prices of all other items of pulses showed an upward trend up to 6% when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the price of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of Redgram, Dhal, Bengalgram Bold and Bengalgram Small decreased by 11.56%,1.61% 7.21% and 11.00% respectively, while the prices of all other items showed an upward trend of 1% to 31%. Notable increase was seen in the price of Greengram (31.11%), Greengram dhal (26.65%) and Blackgram split w/o husk (24.80%) when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year The following table and diagram represents the prices and percentage variation over month and year of pulses.


3. OTHER FOOD ITEMS

Comparison of state average Retail prices of other food items.

During this period a mixed trend was noticed in the state average retail price of other food items when compared with the price of the previous month. The price of Coffee Powder (Brook Bond Gr. Label) showed a negative change, while the prices of all other items showed a nominal increase when compared with the price of the previous month. When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of all items showed an upward trend of 1% to 16%.




4. OIL AND OILSEEDS

Comparison of state average Retail prices of Oil and oilseeds.

A mixed trend is seen in the state average retail price of Oil and Oilseeds during the period under report when compared with the price of both the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year. The state average retail price of Groundnut oil and Refined oil showed a negative change, while the prices of all other items of oil and oil seeds showed an upward up to 9% when compared with the price of the previous month. When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of all items except Groundnut oil and Refined oil increased by 1% to 136%. Notable increase was seen in the price of Coconut oil (136.18%) and Coconut without husk (121.43%) when compared with the price of the corresponding month of the previous year.

5. SPICES AND CONDIMENTS


Comparison of state Average Retail prices of Spices and Condiments:

A mixed trend is still continuing in the State average retail price of spices and condiments during the period under report when compared with the price of both the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year. A negative trend is seen in the state average retail prices of Chilies dry, Cuminseed, and Garlic, while the state average retail prices of all the other items showed an upward trend up to 10% when compared with the price of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of all items except Onion small and Cuminseed showed an upward trend by 1% to 49%. Notable increase was seen in the price of Coriander (22.94%), and Garlic (48.76%) when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year.


6. TUBERS Comparison of state Average Retail prices of Tubers

A mixed trend was observed during the month in the State average retail price of tubers when compared with that of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year. The retail prices of all items of tubers except Tapioca Raw showed an upward trend up to 8% when compared with the prices of the previous month. When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the prices of Chenai, Tapioca Raw and Potato increased by 10.49%, 18.83% and 20.65% respectively, while the state average retail prices of Colocassia showed a negative change .


7. VEGETABLES

Comparison of state average Retail prices of Vegetables.

A mixed trend was observed during the month in the State average retail price of vegetables when compared with that of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year. The prices of Pumpkin, Cucumber, Ladies Finger and Plantain green showed a negative trend of 0.42%, 9.63%, 12.84% and 2.30% respectively while the prices of all other items showed an upward trend up to 10% when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of Brinjal, Pumpkin, Cucumber, Cabbage, Bitter gourd, Tomato and Chilies green showed a negative trend of 9.88%, 13.54%, 3.71%, 6.60%, 3.04%, 43.55% and 4.71% respectively while the prices of all other items showed an increasing trend by 1% to 24%.. The following table and diagram represents the prices and percentage variation over month and year of Vegetables.

8. MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS


Comparison of state Average Retail prices of miscellaneous items

A mixed trend is still continuing in the state average retail prices of miscellaneous items when compared with the prices of the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year. A negative trend is seen in the state average retail prices of paper while the prices of all the other items showed a nominal increase when compared with the prices of the previous month

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year all items except Razor Blade (Topaz), Paper and Cement- Sankar showed an increasing trend by 1% to 18%.
