PREFACE

Price collection is one of the major items of work undertaken by the Department of Economics and Statistics. The importance and usefulness of the information pertaining to the price movements has much significance in the context of a growing economy. This Department has been collecting different types of prices viz. Farm price, Market price, etc. (both Wholesale and Retail). These prices are being widely used for various purposes such as for the preparation of Indices, to provide compensation to Farmer's and for tendering consumable articles for Govt. Institutions. Among the Retail prices, the daily prices of fifty essential commodities being collected on daily basis from District Headquarters assumes significance, because the same is being forwarded daily to the office of the Chief Minister and Minister of Food and Civil Supplies, Minister for Agriculture, Chief Secretary, Food and civil Supplies, Reserve Bank of India etc. In addition to the daily prices, weekly prices are also being collected every Friday.

From January 2004 onwards a publication titled "PRICE BULLETIN" is being prepared and published monthly incorporating the Retail prices of main essential commodities under 8 major groups. Group wise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representations.

This publication is being prepared and published by Prices Division under the supervision of Sri.T.Gorkey Jose, Additional Director (Prices). I appreciate the work done by Smt.L.Sheeja (Assistant Director), Smt.K.Indira Devi (Research Officer), Sri.Sooraj Cheruthottathil (Statistical Assistant Grade I) and all the Price Reporters and Price Supervisers in the Districts for preparing such a worthy publication.

Suggestions if any for improving the publication is solicited.

REVIEW ON RETAIL PRICES OF ESSENTIAL COMMODITIES

JULY 2013

Introduction

This bulletin reflects the average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of July 2013. A mixed trend has been seen in the retail prices under report when compared with that of the corresponding period of the last year as well as the last month. Statement showing the monthly average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of July of the previous year 2012, previous month June 2013 and current month of July 2013 are attached and the percentage variation over previous month and current month of previous year are attached. GroupWise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representation.

1. RICE

Comparison of state average Retail prices of different varieties of Rice

A mixed trend has been observed in the retail prices of Rice during the period under report when compared with the price of the previous month. A nominal increase is seen in the price of Red Chamba and White Andhra vella, the price of Red Matta showed a negative change when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail prices of Red Matta, Red Chamba and White Andhra vella had increased by 28.51%, 31.25% and 13.91% respectively. The following table and diagram represents the prices and percentage variation over month and year of Rice.

2. PULSES

Comparison of state average Retail prices of Pulses.

A mixed trend is still continuing in the retail prices of pulses during the period under report when compared with both the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year. During this period the prices of all items of Pulses except Dhal (Tur) showed a negative change up to 3%, when compared with the price of the previous month. When compared with the price of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of Black gram spilt w/o husk, Redgram, Bengalgram Bold and Bengalgram Small had decreased by 2.00%, 3.71%, 9.81% and 5.39% respectively, while the prices of all other items showed an upward trend of 7% to 16%. The following table and diagram represents the prices and percentage variation over month and year of pulses.

3. OTHER FOOD ITEMS

Comparison of state average Retail prices of other food items.

During this period mixed trend was noticed in the state average retail price of other food items when compared with the price of the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year. The price of Sugar (OM) and Egg (Hens) White Lagon had decreased by 0.07% and 4.93%, while all other items showed an upward trend when compared with the price of the previous month. 'When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of Sugar (OM)had decreased by 2.78%, while the prices of all other items showed an upward trend of 3% to 19%.

4. OIL AND OILSEEDS

Comparison of state average Retail prices of Oil and oilseeds.

A mixed trend was observed during the month in the State average retail price of oil and oil seeds when compared with the price of the previous month. The prices of all items except Groundnut oil showed a negative change when compared with the price of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of all items increased by 6% to 36%. Notable increase was seen in the price of Gingelly oil (35.64%) when compared with the price of the corresponding month of the previous year.

5. SPICES AND CONDIMENTS

Comparison of state Average Retail prices of Spices and Condiments:

A mixed trend is seen in the state average retail price of spices and condiments. A negative trend is seen in the state average retail prices of Coriander, Onion small, Cuminseed and Methy, while the state average retail prices of all the other items showed a marginal increase when compared with the price of the previous month.

Tamarind without seeds loose showed a negative change of (1.41 %), while the state average retail prices of all other items increased by 1% to 54 % when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year. Notable increase was seen in the retail prices of Onion small (53.25%) Coriander (40.43%), and Turmeric (36.63%) when compared with the prices of the the corresponding month of the previous year.

6. TUBERS

Comparison of state Average Retail prices of Tubers

During this period the prices of all items of tubers except Tapioca raw showed a downward trend when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of corresponding month of the previous year the prices of all items except Potato showed an increasing trend by 1% to 78%. Notable increase was seen in the retail prices of Tapioca Raw (78.09%), when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year.

7. VEGETABLES

Comparison of state average Retail prices of Vegetables.

A mixed trend was observed during the month in the State average retail price of vegetables compared with that of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year. The prices of Brinjal, Pumpkin, Ladys Finger, Bittergourd, Tomatto and Chillies green showed a downward trend of 3.81%, 0.29%, 4.05%, 4.97%, 17.85% and 7.66% respectively, while the prices of all other items showed an upward trend of 1% to 31% when compared with the prices of the previous month.

The state average a retail prices of Pumpkin (6.37%) and Chillies green (2.83%) and showed a negative trend, while the prices of all other items increased by 10% to 123% when compared with the prices of corresponding month of the previous year. Notable increase was seen in the price of Onion big (123.87%), Cucumber (35.39%), Ladies Finger (57.31%) Bittergourd (36.46%) and Tomato (59.30%), when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year. The following table and diagram represents the prices and percentage variation over month and year of Vegetables.

8. MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

Comparison of state Average Retail prices of miscellaneous items

A mixed trend is still continuing in the state average retail prices of miscellaneous items when compared with the prices of the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year. A negative trend is seen in the state average retail prices of Tobacco (0.97%), Toilet Soap-Lux (0.25%) and Cement – Sankar (0.61%) while all the other items showed a marginal increase when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year all items except Crocin and Cement – Sankar showed an increasing trend by 4% to 31%. Notable increase was seen in the state average retail price of Tobacco (31.12%).
