

PREFACE

Price collection is one of the major items of work undertaken by the Department of Economics and Statistics. The importance and usefulness of the information pertaining to the price movements has much significance in the context of a growing economy. This Department has been collecting different types of prices viz. Farm price, Market price, etc. (both Wholesale and Retail). These prices are being widely used for various purposes such as for the preparation of Indices, to provide compensation to Farmer's and for tendering consumable articles for Govt. Institutions. Among the Retail prices, the daily prices of fifty essential commodities being collected on daily basis from District Headquarters assumes significance, because the same is being forwarded daily to the office of the Chief Minister and Minister of Food and Civil Supplies, Minister for Agriculture, Chief Secretary, Food and civil Supplies Secretary, Planning secretary, Agr. Production Commissioner, Department of Civil supplies, Reserve Bank of India etc. In addition to the daily prices, weekly prices are also being collected every Friday.

From January 2004 onwards a publication titled "PRICE BULLETIN" is being prepared and published monthly incorporating the Retail prices of main essential commodities under 8 major groups. Group wise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representations.

This publication is being prepared and published by Prices Division under the supervision of Sri.T.Gorkey Jose, Additional Director (Prices). I appreciate the work done by Smt.L.Sheeja (Assistant Director), Smt.K.Indira Devi (Research Officer), Sri.Sooraj Cheruthottathil (Statistical Assistant Grade I) and all the Price Reporters and Price Supervisors in the Districts for preparing such a worthy publication.

REVIEW ON RETAIL PRICES OF ESSENTIAL COMMODITIES

SEPTEMBER 2013

Introduction

This bulletin reflects the average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of September 2013. A mixed trend has been seen in the retail prices under report when compared with that of the last month. But an increasing trend was seen when compared with that of the corresponding month of previous year. Statement showing the monthly average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of September of the previous year 2012, previous month August 2013 and current month of September 2013 are attached and the percentage variation over previous month and current month of previous year are attached. GroupWise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representation.

1. RICE

Comparison of state average Retail prices of different varieties of Rice


A mixed trend has been observed in the retail prices of Rice during the period under report when compared with the price of the previous month. A nominal increase is seen in the price of Red Chamba, Red Matta and White Andhra vella showed a negative change when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, the state average retail prices of Red Matta, Red Chamba and White Andhra vella had increased by 16.98%, 18.79% and 7.48% respectively. The following table and diagram represents the prices and percentage variation over month and year of Rice

Comparison of state average Retail prices of Pulses.

A mixed trend is seen in the retail price of pulses when compared with the price of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year. The prices of Redgram, Bengalgram Bold and Bengalgram Small had decreased by 3.43%, 0.90%, and 1.70% respectively, and the prices of all other items increased up to 4%, when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with price of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of Greengram, Greengram dhal and Peas Dhall increased by 6.33%,7.37%, and 6.99% respectively, while the prices of all other items showed downward trend of 1% to 21%. The following table and diagram represents the prices and percentage variation over month and year of pulses.



3. OTHER FOOD ITEMS

Comparison of state average Retail prices of other food items.

During this period a mixed trend was noticed in the state average retail price of other food items when compared with the price of the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year. The price of Sugar (OM) and Coffee Powder (Brook Bond Gr.Label) showed a negative change, while the prices of all other items increased by up to 2%, when compared with the price of the previous month. 'When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of Sugar (OM) and Egg (Hens) White Lagon decreased by 13.61% and 5.30%, respectively while the prices of all other items showed an upward trend of 4% to 19%.

4. OIL AND OILSEEDS


Comparison of state average Retail prices of Oil and oilseeds.

A mixed trend was observed during the month in the State average retail price of oil and oil seeds when compared with the price of the previous month. The prices of all items except Groundnut oil and Gingelly oil showed a positive change when compared with the price of the previous month. When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of all items increased by 1% to 30%. Notable increase was seen in the price of Coconut oil (29.46%), Gingelly oil (24.50%) and Coconut without husk (28.97%) when compared with the price of the corresponding month of the previous year

5. SPICES AND CONDIMENTS

Comparison of state Average Retail prices of Spices and Condiments:


A mixed trend is still continuing in the retail prices of spices and condiments during the period under report when compared with both the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year. A negative trend is seen in the state average retail prices of Coriander, Cuminseed and Mustard, while the state average retail prices of all the other items showed a nominal increase when compared with the price of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of all items except Mustard and Cuminseed showed an upward trend by 3% to 87%. Notable increase was seen in the price of Coriander (30.58%), Onion small (86.84%) Turmeric (32.61%) and Garlic (38.05%), when compared with the price of the corresponding month of the previous year.

6. TUBERS


Comparison of state Average Retail prices of Tubers

During this period the prices of all items of tubers except Chenai and Potato showed an upward trend when compared with the prices of the previous month. When compared with the prices of corresponding month of the previous year the prices of all items except Potato showed an increasing trend by 10% to 90%. Notable increase was seen in the retail prices of Tapioca Raw (90.35%)) and Chenai (17.26%), when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year.

7. VEGETABLES

Comparison of state average Retail prices of Vegetables.


A mixed trend was observed during the month in the State average retail price of vegetables compared with that of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year. The price of Onion big, Brinjal, Pumpkin, tomato and Banana green showed an upward trend of 14.76%, 1.04%, 0.08%, 3.34% and 3.67% respectively, while the prices of all other items showed a downward trend of 1% to 18% when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year all items except Cucumber showed an increasing trend by 6% to 295%.. Notable increase was seen in the price of Onion big (294.75%), Brinjal (61.35%) Cabbage (74.66%), Bittergourd (40.24%), Ashguard (48.99%), Chilies green (70.40%) and Banana green (79.29%) when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year. 8. MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

Comparison of state Average Retail prices of miscellaneous items


A mixed trend is still continuing in the state average retail prices of miscellaneous items when compared with the prices of the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year. A negative trend is seen in the state average retail prices of Tobacco (2.21%), and Toothpaste Colgate (0.06%) while all the other items showed a marginal increase in price when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, all items except Crocin and Cement – Sankar showed an increasing trend by 2% to 25%. Notable increase was seen in the state average retail price of Tobacco (25.25%).
