

#### **PREFACE**

Price collection is one of the major items of work undertaken by the Department of Economics and Statistics. The importance and usefulness of the information pertaining to the price movements has much significance in the context of a growing economy. This Department has been collecting different types of prices viz. Farm price, Market price, etc. (both Wholesale and Retail). These prices are being widely used for various purposes such as for the preparation of Indices, to provide compensation to Farmer's and for tendering consumable articles for Govt. Institutions. Among the Retail prices, the daily prices of fifty essential commodities being collected on daily basis from District Headquarters assumes significance, because the same is being forwarded daily to the office of the Chief Minister and Minister of Food and Civil Supplies, Minister for Agriculture, Chief Secretary, Food and civil Supplies Secretary, Planning secretary, Agr. Production Commissioner, Department of Civil supplies, Reserve Bank of India etc. In addition to the daily prices, weekly prices are also being collected every Friday.

From January 2004 onwards a publication titled "PRICE BULLETIN" is being prepared and published monthly, incorporating the Retail prices of main essential commodities under 8 major groups. Group wise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representations.

This publication is being prepared and published by Prices Division under the supervision of Sri.T.Gorkey Jose, Additional Director (Prices). I appreciate the work done by Smt.L.Sheeja (Assistant Director), Smt.K.Indira Devi (Research Officer), Sri.Sooraj Cheruthottathil (Statistical Assistant Grade I) and all the Price Reporters and Price Supervisers in the Districts for preparing such a worthy publication.

Suggestions if any for improving the publication is solicited.

#### REVIEW ON RETAIL PRICES OF ESSENTIAL COMMODITIES

#### **NOVEMBER 2013**

#### Introduction

This bulletin reflects the average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of November 2013. A mixed trend has been seen in the retail prices under report when compared with that of the corresponding period of the last year as well as the last month. Statement showing the monthly average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of November of the previous year 2012, previous month October 2013 and current month of November 2013 are attached and the percentage variation over previous month and current month of previous year are attached. GroupWise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representations.

## 1. RICE

#### Comparison of State average retail prices of different varieties of Rice


During this period a mixed trend was observed in the retail prices of Rice during the period under report when compared with the price of the previous month. A nominal increase is seen in the price of White Andhra vella. Red Matta and Red Chamba showed a negative change when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail prices of Red Matta, Red Chamba and White Andhra vella had increased by 9.14%, 14.04% and 3.11% respectively. The following table and diagram represents the prices and percentage variation over month and year of Rice.

#### 2. PULSES

#### Comparison of State average retail prices of Pulses.


A mixed trend is seen in the retail prices of pulses when compared with the price of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year. The prices of Bengalgram Small had decreased by 0.24%, while the prices of all other items increased up to 5%, when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the price of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of Greengram, Greengram dhal, Black gram spilt w/o husk, with husk and Peas Dhal increased by 9.33%,7.82%,2.15%,2.02% and 13.62% respectively, while the prices of all other items showed a downward trend of 1% to 21%. The following table and diagram represents the prices and percentage variation over month and year of pulses.

#### 3. OTHER FOOD ITEMS


#### Comparison of State average retail prices of other food items.

During this period a mixed trend was noticed in the state average retail price of other food items when compared with the price of the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year. The price of Sugar (OM) and Baby Food (Amul) showed a negative change, while the prices of all other items increased upto 11%, when compared with the price of the previous month. When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, the state average retail price Sugar (OM) had decreased by 13.25% while the prices of all other items showed an upward trend of 1% to 22%. Notable increase was seen in the price of Tea (Kannan Devan) (21.59%) when compared with the price of the corresponding month of the previous year.

#### 4. OIL AND OILSEEDS


#### Comparison of State average retail prices of Oil and oilseeds.

A mixed trend is still continuing in the State average retail price of oil and oil seeds when compared with the price of the previous month. The prices of all items except Groundnut oil and Gingelly oil showed an upward trend when compared with the price of the previous month. When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of all items increased by 1% to 69%. Notable increase was seen in the price of Coconut oil (64.17%), Gingelly oil (23.85%) and Coconut without husk (68.84%) when compared with the price of the corresponding month of the previous year.

#### 5. SPICES AND CONDIMENTS

#### Comparison of State average retail prices of Spices and Condiments:


A mixed trend is seen in the retail prices of spices and condiments during the period under report when compared with both the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year. A negative trend is seen in the state average retail prices of Tamarind without seeds loose and Turmeric, while the state average retail prices of all the other items showed an upward trend by 1% to 30% when compared with the price of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of all items except Mustard and Cuminseed showed an upward trend by 1% to 86%. Notable increase was seen in the price of Coriander (32.18%), Onion small (74.56%) Turmeric (23.98%) and Garlic (85.98%), when compared with the price of the corresponding month of the previous year.

#### 6. TUBERS


#### Comparison of State average retail prices of Tubers

During this period the prices of all items of tubers except Chenai and Colocassia showed an upward trend when compared with the prices of the previous month. When compared with the prices of corresponding month of the previous year the prices of all items showed an increasing trend by 19% to 91%. Notable increase was seen in the retail prices of Tapioca Raw (91.11%)) and Potato (36.72%) when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year.

#### 7. VEGETABLES


#### Comparison of State average retail prices of Vegetables.

A mixed trend was observed during the month in the State average retail price of vegetables compared with that of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year. The prices of Ladies Finger, Cabbage, Tomato, Banana green and Plantain green showed an upward trend of 8.94%, 3.86%, 20.72%, 1.89% and 1.11% respectively while the prices of all other items showed a downward trend of 1% to 12% when compared with the prices of the previous month. When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of Cucumber and Snake gourd showed a negative trend while the prices of all other items increased by 1% to 164%. Notable increase was seen in the price of Onion big (163.58%), Brinjal (26.99%) Cabbage (47.18%), Tomato (91.26%) Chilies green (23.38%) and Banana green (45.38%) when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year. The following table and diagram represents the prices and percentage variation over month and year of Vegetables.

### Comparison of State average retail prices of miscellaneous items


A mixed trend is still continuing in the state average retail prices of miscellaneous items when compared with the prices of the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year. A negative trend is seen in the state average retail prices of Cement –Sankar (0.77%), while the prices of all the other items showed a marginal increase when compared with the prices of the previous month

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year all items except Razor Blade (Topaz) showed an increasing trend by 1% to 19%. Notable increase was seen in the state average retail price of Tobacco (19.39%).
