

PREFACE

Price collection is one of the major items of work undertaken by the Department of Economics and Statistics. The importance and usefulness of the information pertaining to the price movements has much significance in the context of a growing economy. This Department has been collecting different types of prices viz. Farm price, Market price, etc. (both Wholesale and Retail). These prices are being widely used for various purposes such as for the preparation of Indices, to provide compensation to Farmer's and for tendering consumable articles for Govt. Institutions. Among the Retail prices, the daily prices of fifty essential commodities being collected on daily basis from District Headquarters assumes significance, because the same is being forwarded daily to the office of the Chief Minister and Minister of Food and Civil Supplies, Minister for Agriculture, Chief Secretary, Food and civil Supplies Secretary, Planning secretary, Agr. Production Commissioner, Department of Civil supplies, Reserve Bank of India etc. In addition to the daily prices, weekly prices are also being collected every Friday.

From January 2004 onwards a publication titled "PRICE BULLETIN" is being prepared and published monthly incorporating the Retail prices of main essential commodities under 8 major groups. Group wise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representations.

This publication is being prepared and published by Prices Division under the supervision of Sri.T.Gorkey Jose, Additional Director (Prices). I appreciate the work done by Smt.L.Sheeja (Assistant Director), Smt.K.Indira Devi (Research Officer), Sri.Sooraj Cheruthottathil (Statistical Assistant Grade II) and all the Price Reporters and Price Supervisers in the Districts for preparing such a worthy publication.

Suggestions if any for improving the publication is solicited.

REVIEW ON RETAIL PRICES OF ESSENTIAL COMMODITIES

AUGUST 2012

Introduction

This bulletin reflects the average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of August 2012. A mixed trend has been seen in the retail prices under report when compared with that of the corresponding period of the last year as well as the last month. Statement showing the monthly average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of August of the previous year 2011, previous month July 2012 and current month of August 2012 are attached and the percentage variation over previous month and current month of previous year are attached. GroupWise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representation.

1. RICE


Comparison of State average retail prices of different varieties of Rice

An upward trend has been observed in the retail prices of rice during the period under report when compared with both previous month and year. Nominal increase is seen in the price of Red-Matta (5.01% and 17.50%). Red -Chamba (7.43% and 16.60%) and white Andra Vella (1.52% and 17.64%) respectively over previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year. The following table and diagram represents the prices and percentage variation over month and year of Rice.

2. PULSES


Comparison of State average retail prices of Pulses.

During this period a upward trend has been seen in the retail prices of pulses when compared with the price of the previous month. The price of all items of this group increased by 4% to 13% when compared with the price of the previous month. When compared with the prices of the previous year Black gram split without husk, and with husk showed a slightly negative change and all other items increased by 3% to 70%. Notable increase was seen in the price of Redgram, Bengalgram Bold and Bengalgram small when compared with the price of the corresponding month of the previous year. The following Table & diagram represents the prices and percentage variation over month and year of pulses.

3. OTHER FOOD ITEMS


Comparison of State average retail prices of other food items.

During this period the state average retail prices of all the items of other food items except milk(cow's) showed a nominal increase when compared with the previous month. Milk (Cow's) showed a slight variation when compared with the price of the previous month. The prices of all items of this group increased by 7% to 31% when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year.

4. OIL AND OILSEEDS

Comparison of State average retail prices of Oil and oilseeds.


A mixed trend was seen in the state average retail prices of Oil and Oil seeds compared with the price of the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year. Negative trend is seen in the state average retail price of Coconut oil and Refined Oil when compared with the price of previous month. The price of Groundnut Oil, Gingelly oil and Coconut without husk has increased by 1.49%, 2.85% and 1.45% respectively.

When compared with the price of the previous year state average retail price of Coconut oil and Coconut without husk has gone down by 34.82% and 26.94%, while Groundnut oil, Refined oil and Gingelly oil increased by 28.32%, 4.51% and 18.81% respectively.

5. SPICES AND CONDIMENTS

Comparison of State average retail prices of Spices and Condiments:


A mixed trend is seen in the State average retail price of spices and condiments. A negative trend is seen in the state average retail price of Onion small (6.70%) Tamarind without seeds loose (4.04%) and Garlic (5.77%) while the state average retail prices of all the other items showed a marginal increase when compared with the price of previous month.

Chillies dry, Tamarind without seed loose, Turmeric and Garlic showed a downward trend of 30.75%, 7.41%, 43.56% and 40.90% respectively, while all the other items showed an upward trend when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of previous year.

6. TUBERS


Comparison of State average retail prices of Tubers

During this period the state average retail price of Chenai and Colocassia showed a decreasing trend while Tapioca raw and Potato showed an increasing trend when compared with the prices of the previous month. The state average retail prices of Chenai and Tapioca raw showed a downward trend of 3.35% and 16.03% respectively. While the prices of all the other items showed an upward trend when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the

7. VEGETABLES

Comparison of State average retail prices of Vegetables.


A mixed trend was seen in the state average retail prices of vegetables compared with the price of both previous month and year. The price of Onion big (4.57%), Cucumber (17.90%) Lady's finger (21.11%) and Plantain green (4.77) showed an increase while all the other items showed a decreasing trend when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of previous year, all items except Onion big, Bitter gourd and Ash gourd showed an increasing trend. The price of Onion big, Bitter gourd and Ash guard decreased by 23.69%, 4.66% and 2.72% respectively, while the price of Brinjal(18.89%), Pumpkin (27.57%), Cucumber (26.53%), Lady's finger (44.26%), Cabbage (46.24%), Snake guard (1.29%), Tomato (55.24%), Chilies green (12.25%), Banana green (0.37%), and Plantain green (51.67%) showed an increasing trend when compared with the price of corresponding month of the previous year.

8. MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

Comparison of State average retail prices of miscellaneous items


In this group the price of almost all the items showed a nominal increase with respect to the State average retail prices of the previous month. Almost all the items exhibited a slight increase in price except Cement- Sankar, that decreased by 0.34% when compared with the price of previous month.

When compared with the price of the previous year, all items except paper showed an increasing trend while the state average retail price of paper decreased by 12.54%.
