

PREFACE

Price collection is one of the major items of work undertaken by the Department of Economics and Statistics. The importance and usefulness of the information pertaining to the price movements has much significance in the context of a growing economy. This Department has been collecting different types of prices viz. Farm price, Market price, etc. (both Wholesale and Retail). These prices are being widely used for various purposes such as for the preparation of Indices, to provide compensation to Farmer's and for tendering consumable articles for Govt. Institutions. Among the Retail prices, the daily prices of fifty essential commodities being collected on daily basis from District Headquarters assumes significance, because the same is being forwarded daily to the office of the Chief Minister and Minister of Food and Civil Supplies, Minister for Agriculture, Chief Secretary, Food and civil Supplies Secretary, Planning secretary, Agr. Production Commissioner, Department of Civil supplies, Reserve Bank of India etc. In addition to the daily prices, weekly prices are also being collected every Friday.

From January 2004 onwards a publication titled "PRICE BULLETIN" is being prepared and published monthly incorporating the Retail prices of main essential commodities under 8 major groups. Group wise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representations.

This publication is being prepared and published by Prices Division under the supervision of Sri.T.Gorkey Jose, Additional Director (Prices). I appreciate the work done by Smt.L.Sheeja (Assistant Director), Smt.K.Indira Devi (Research Officer), Sri.Sooraj Cheruthottathil (Statistical Assistant Grade II) and all the Price Reporters and Price Supervisers in the Districts for preparing such a worthy publication.

Suggestions if any for improving the publication is solicited.

REVIEW ON RETAIL PRICES OF ESSENTIAL COMMODITIES

SEPTEMBER 2012

Introduction

This bulletin reflects the average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of September 2012. An Increasing trend has been seen in the retail prices under report when compared with that of the corresponding period of the last year as well as the last month. Statement showing the monthly average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of September of the previous year 2011, previous month August 2012 and current month of September 2012 are attached and the percentage variation over previous month and current month of previous year are attached. GroupWise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representation.

1. RICE

Comparison of State average retail prices of different varieties of Rice

An upward trend is still continuing in the retail price of rice during the period under report when compared with both the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year. A nominal increase is seen in the Rice of Red-matta (3.52% and 23.25%), Red-Chamba (3.74% and 22.35%), and White Andravella (3.50% and 20.71%) respectively over the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year respectively. The following table and diagram represents the prices and percentage variation over month and year of Rice.

2. PULSES


Comparison of State average retail prices of Pulses.

A mixed trend is seen in the retail prices of pulses when compared with the price of the previous month and year. A nominal decrease in the price of green gram was noticed while all other items showed a marginal increase in prices when compared with the price of the previous month. When compared with the corresponding month of the price of the previous year, Black gram split without husk and with husk showed a negative change and the price of all other items increased by 4% to 67% notable increase was showed in the prices of Red gram, Bengal gram bold, Bengal gram small, when compared with the price of the corresponding month of the previous year. The following table and diagram represents the prices and percentage variation over month and year of pulses.

3. OTHER FOOD ITEMS


Comparison of State average retail prices of other food items.

During this period the State average retail price of all the items of other food items except Milk (Cow's) and Sugar showed a nominal increase when compared with the price of the previous month. Sugar (O.M) and Milk Cow's showed a negative change up to 1% when compared with the prices of all items of this group increased by 3% to 36% when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year.

4. OIL AND OILSEEDS


Comparison of State average retail prices of Oil and oilseeds.

A mixed trend has been seen in the retail prices of oil and oilseeds compared with the price of the previous month and previous year. Negative trend is still continuing in the state average retail price of Coconut Oil and all other items of this group showed a nominal increase by 1 to 2% when compared with the price of previous month.

When compared with the price of previous year state average retail price of Coconut oil and Coconut without husk has gone down by 31.03% and 23.98%, while groundnut oil and refined oil and gingerly oil increased by 26.37%, 4.99% and 20.23% respectively

5. SPICES AND CONDIMENTS

Comparison of State average retail prices of Spices and Condiments:


A mixed trend is seen in the state average retail price of spices and condiments. A negative trend is still continuing in the State average retail price of Onion Small (3.79%) Tamarind without seed loose (0.87%) and garlic (3.38%) while the state average retail prices of all other items showed a marginal increase when compared with the price of previous month.

Coriander, Chillies dry, Tamarind without seed loose, Turmeric and garlic showed a downward trend of 4.87%, 28.60%, 10.53%, 35.74% and 45.31% respectively. While all other items showed upward trend when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of previous year..

6. TUBERS


Comparison of State average retail prices of Tubers

During this period the state average retail price of Chenai and potato showed a decreasing trend while Tapioca raw and Colocassia showed an increasing trend when compared with the prices of the previous month. The state average retail prices of Chenai and Tapioca raw whosed a downward trend of 7.35% and 14.20? % respectively whiles the prices of potato (40.68%) and Colocassia (77.94%) showed an increasing trend when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year.

7. VEGETABLES

Comparison of State average retail prices of Vegetables.


A mixed trend was seen in the state average retail prices of vegetables compared with the prices of both previous month and year. The price of Onion leaves (3.21%), coriander (13.30%), Lady's finger(0.49%), Bittergaurd (10.90%), Ash guard (0.42%), Snakeguard (24.56%) and chilles green (4.91%) showed an increase while Brinjol (2.21%), Pumpkin(3.89%), Cabbage (3.46%), Tomatto (2.78%), Bananagreen (10.67%) and plantain green (2.4%) showed a decreasing trend when compared with the prices of the previous month.

The state average retail prices of onion leaf (27.01%), Brinjol (3.74%), Ash guard (1.39%) and Banana green showed an downward trend, while the prices of all other items increased by 1% to 45%, notable increase was showed in the price of plantain green, Cucumber, when compared with the price of the corresponding month of the previous year.

8. MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS


Comparison of State average retail prices of miscellaneous items

In this group the price of all items except (Crown and Cement Sankar-ord) showed a nominal increase with respect to the state average retail prices of the previous month. The price of Crown and Cement Sankar showed a slight negative change up to 1% when compared with the price of previous month. When compared with the prices of the previous year. All items except paper showed an increasing trend while the state average retail price of paper decreased by 12.54%.
