#### **PREFACE**

Price collection is one of the major items of work undertaken by the Department of Economics and Statistics. The importance and usefulness of the information pertaining to the price movements has much significance. This Department has been collecting different types of prices viz. Farm price, Market price, etc. (both Wholesale and Retail). These prices are being widely used for various purposes such as for the preparation of Indices, to provide compensation to Farmers and for tendering consumable articles for Govt. Institutions. Among the Retail prices, the statement of daily prices of fifty essential commodities being collected on daily basis from District Headquarters assume significance, because it is being forwarded daily to the office of the Chief Minister and Minister of Food and Civil Supplies, Minister for Agriculture, Chief Secretary, Food and civil Supplies Secretary, Planning secretary, Department of Civil supplies, Reserve Bank of India, Consumerfed etc. In addition to the daily prices, weekly prices are also being collected every Friday.

From January 2004 onwards a publication titled "PRICE BULLETIN" is being prepared and published monthly incorporating the Retail prices of main essential commodities under 8 major groups. Group wise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representations.

This publication is being prepared and published by Prices Division. I appreciate the work done by Sri.P.D.SanthoshKumar, Additional Director (State Income). Smt.Haleema Beegam (Joint Director), Sri.Rajendran Kuttikadu (Assistant Director), Smt.Sarulatha (Research Officer), Sri.Sooraj Cheruthottathil (Statistical Assistant Grade-I) and all the Price Reporters and Price Supervisors in the Districts for preparing such a worthy publication.

### REVIEW ON RETAIL PRICES OF ESSENTIAL COMMODITIES

# **JUNE-2022**

# **INTRODUCTION**

This bulletin reflects the average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of June 2022. A mixed trend has been seen in the retail prices under report when compared with that of the last months as well as the corresponding month of previous year. Statement showing the monthly average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of June of the previous year 2021, previous month May 2022 and current month of June 2022 along with the percentage of variation over the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year are included in this report. Group Wise analysis has been made with reference to the current month, the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representation.

#### 1. RICE

#### Comparison of state average Retail prices of different varieties of Rice

During the month mixed trend was observed in the state average retail price of Rice varieties when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

The State average retail prices of White Andhra Vella increased by 3.92 % and Red Matta decreased by 0.50%. While the retail prices of Red Chamba remain stable when compared with the prices of the previous month.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, the state average retail prices of Red Matta and White Andhra Vella increased by 13.63% and 11.56 % while that of Red Chamba decreased by 3.75%.

#### 2. PULSES

# Comparison of state average Retail prices of Pulses.

During the month a decreasing trend was observed in the state average retail price of Pulses when compared with the prices of the previous month, and a mixed trend was observed in the corresponding month of the previous year

When compared with the prices of previous month, a decreasing trend was observed in the state average retail price of Pulses except the price of Black gram Split without husk and Tur dhal. Notable decrease was seen in the price of Peas dhal (2.97%). All the remaining items showed marginal fluctuations.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of pulses showed a mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Red gram (7.74%), and Notable decrease was seen in the price of Green gram (7.61%) and Green gram dhal (5.19%).

#### 3. OTHER FOOD ITEMS

#### Comparison of state average Retail prices of other food items.

During the month an increasing trend was observed in the state average retail price of other food items when compared with the prices of the previous month. However when compared with the corresponding month of the previous year an increasing trend was observed.

The State average retail price of all items in this group showed a marginal upward trend or remain stable when compared with the prices of the previous month. Notable increase was seen in the price of Egg (Hens)White Lagon(13.84%). The prices of Sugar, Tea (Kannan Devan), Coffee powder (Brookbond) showed slight increase while the prices of Milk (Cows), Baby food (Amul) and Mutton with Bones remain stable.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of Other Food Items showed an increasing trend except the prices of Tea (Kannan Devan) and Egg(Hens)White Lagon. Notable increase was seen in the price of Baby food (Amul) (12.49%) and Sugar (5.91%) while notable decrease was seen in the price of Egg (Hens) White Lagon (2.24) %.

#### 4. OIL AND OILSEEDS

#### Comparison of state average Retail prices of Oil and oilseeds.

During the month a decreasing trend was observed in the state average retail price of Oil and Oil seeds when compared with the prices of the previous month while a mixed trend was observed in the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of previous month, the State average retail prices of Oil and Oilseeds showed downward trend up to 5.70 % except the price of Gingelly Oil. Notable decrease was seen in the price of Coconut without husk (5.70 %)


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of Oil and Oilseeds showed the mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Refined Oil (11.17%), while notable decrease was seen in the price of Coconut oil (21.14%) and coconut without husk (18.21%).

#### 5. SPICES AND CONDIMENTS

#### **Comparison of state Average Retail prices of Spices and Condiments:**

During the month a mixed trend was observed in the State average retail price of spices and Condiments when compared with the price of the previous month as well as with the corresponding month of the previous year.

The state average retail price of Spices and Condiments showed a mixed trend when compared with the price of the previous month. Notable increase was seen in the price of Onion Small(5.33%) and Chillies Dry (3.75%) while all the remaining items showed marginal variation.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, the state average retail price of Spices and Condiments showed a mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Coriander (59.33%), Chillies dry (34.05%), Mustard(22.37%) and Methy (19.42%), while notable decrease was seen in the price of Onion small (44.81%) and Garlic (32.04%).

#### 6. TUBERS

#### **Comparison of state Average Retail prices of Tubers**

During the month an increasing trend was observed in the state average retail price of Tubers when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the price of the previous month, the state average retail price of all items of Tubers showed an upward trend up to 16.13%. Notable increase was seen in the price of Elephant Yam (16.13%) and Tapioca Raw(15.79%)


Increasing trend was observed in the retail prices of Tubers when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year. Notable increase was seen in the price of Tapioca raw (77.02%) and Coloccassia(70.48%).

#### 7. VEGETABLES

#### Comparison of state average Retail prices of Vegetables.

During the month mixed trend was observed in the State average retail price of vegetables when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of the previous month, the state average retail prices of vegetables showed a mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Cabbage(60.99%), Pumpkin (16.46%), Ashguard (15.36%) and Plantain green(14.19%)while notable decrease was seen in the price of Ladies finger(15.44%), Tomato (14.65%) and Bitter guard(10.48%)


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, the state average retail price of all items of vegetables showed mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Tomato (185.44%), Cabbage (97.05%),Banana green (67.54%), Plantain green(43.46%),and Brinjal(19.81%), while notable decrease was seen in the price of onion Big (21.30%) and Cucumber(18.51%).

#### 8. MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

#### Comparison of state Average Retail prices of miscellaneous items

During the month mixed trend was observed in the state average retail price of this group when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of the previous month, the state average retail prices of all items of this group showed marginal increase except the price of Cement, Firewood Split (Local) and Tobacco. Notable increase was seen in the price of Washing Soda (7.31%).


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of this group showed mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Toilet Soap –Lux (22.64%), Washing soda (17.47%), Toothpase –Colgate (13.69%), Torch Battery (Eveready) (12.47%) and Crocin (12.40%) while notable decrease was seen in the price of Cement-Sankar (Ord. Paper Bag) (15.21%).
