PREFACE

Price collection is one of the major item of work undertaken by the Department of Economics and Statistics. The importance and usefulness of the information pertaining to the price movements has much significance in the context of a growing economy. This Department has been collecting different types of prices viz. Farm price, Market price, etc. (both Wholesale and Retail). These prices are being widely used for various purposes such as for the preparation of Indices, to provide compensation to Farmer's and for tendering consumable articles for Govt. Institutions. Among the Retail prices, the daily prices of fifty essential commodities being collected on daily basis from District Headquarters assumes significance, because the same is being forwarded daily to the office of the Chief Minister and Minister of Food and Civil Supplies, Minister for Agriculture, Chief Secretary, Food and civil Supplies Secretary, Planning secretary, Agr. Production Commissioner, Department of Civil supplies, Reserve Bank of India etc. In addition to the daily prices, weekly prices are also being collected every Friday.

From January 2004 onwards a publication titled "PRICE BULLETIN" is being prepared and published monthly incorporating the Retail prices of main essential commodities under 8 major groups. Group wise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representations.

This publication is being prepared and published by Prices Division under the supervision of Sri.T.Gorkey Jose, Additional Director (Prices). I appreciate the work done by Smt.L.Sheeja (Assistant Director), Smt.K.Indira Devi (Research Officer), Sri.Sooraj Cheruthottathil (Statistical Assistant Grade I) and all the Price Reporters and Price Supervisers in the Districts for preparing such a worthy publication.

Suggestions if any for improving the publication is solicited.

REVIEW ON RETAIL PRICES OF ESSENTIAL COMMODITIES

DECEMBER 2012

Introduction

This bulletin reflects the average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of December 2012. A mixed trend has been seen in the retail prices under report when compared with that of the corresponding period of the last year as well as the last month. Statement showing the monthly average of retail prices on all Fridays of essential commodities as on December 2011, November -2012 and December -2012 are attached and the percentage variation over previous month and current month of previous year are attached. Groupwise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representation.

1. RICE

Comparison of State average retail prices of different varieties of Rice

An upward trend is still continuing in the retail price of Rice during the period under report when compared with the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year. Notable increase in price is seen in the price of Red-matta (8.71% and 41.73%) Red-Chamba (8.62% and 35.78%) and white Andra vella (1.93% and 24.46%) respectively over the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year respectively. The following table and diagram represents the prices and percentage variation over month and year of Rice.


2. PULSES

Comparison of State average retail prices of Pulses.

A mixed trend is seen in the retail prices of pulses when compared with the price of the previous month and year. A nominal increase is seen in the prices of Green gram, Red gram and Greengram Dhall, while the prices of all other items show a marginal decrease when compared with the price of the previous month. When compared with the price of the corresponding month of the previous year Black gram split with husk and without husk showed a negative change while the prices of all the other items increased by 6% to 60%. Notable increase was seen in the price of Redgram, Bengal gram bold, Peas Dhal and Bengal gram small when compared with the price of the corresponding month of previous year. The following Table and diagram represents the prices and percentage variation over month and year of pulses.

3. OTHER FOOD ITEMS


Comparison of State average retail prices of other food items.

During this period a mixed trend was noticed in the state average retail prices of other food items items when compared with the price of the previous month. The price of sugar (OM), Egg (hens) white lagoon decreased by 1.72% and 4.63% respectively while the prices of all other items increased by 1% to 4%. when compared with the prices of the previous month. The prices of all items of this group increased by 5% to 20% when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year.

4. OIL AND OILSEEDS


Comparison of State average retail prices of Oil and oilseeds.

During this period the prices of all items of oil and oil seeds showed an upward trend when compared with the price of the previous month. when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the State average retail price of coconut oil, and coconut without husk decreased by 19.71% and 20.53% while the prices of ground nut oil, Refined oil and Gingelly oil increased by 16.60%, 6.84% and 15.44% respectively.

Comparison of State average retail prices of Spices and Condiments:


A mixed trend is seen in the state average retail price of spices and condiments. A negative trend is seen in the state average retail price of Mustard and methy while the state average retail prices of all the other items showed a marginal increase when compared with the price of the previous month.

Onion small, Cumin seed, Mustard and methy showed an upward trend of 76.37%, 5.66%, 28.33%, and 13.51% respectively while all the other items showed a downward trend when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year.

6. TUBERS


Comparison of State average retail prices of Tubers

During this period the prices of all items of Tubers except Colocassia showed an increasing trend when compared with the prices of the previous month. Tapioca Raw showed a downward trend by 3.53% while all other items showed an upward trend when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year.

7. VEGETABLES

Comparison of State average retail prices of Vegetables.


A mixed trend was observed during the month in the State average retail price of vegetables compared with that of the previous months well as the corresponding month of the previous year. The price of onion big (11.03%) Cabbage (1.29%), Tomato (12.36%), Chillies green (3.29%) and Plantain green (4.34%) increased while the prices of all the other items showed a downward trend when compared with the prices of the previous month.

The State average retail prices of Cabbage (4.40%), Bitter gourd (2.49%), and Snake gourd (1.06%) showed a negative trend, while the prices of all other items increased by 4% to 51% when compared with the price of the corresponding month of the previous year.

8. MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS


Comparison of State average retail prices of miscellaneous items
