PREFACE

Price collection is one of the major items of work undertaken by the Department of Economics and Statistics. The importance and usefulness of the information pertaining to the price movements has much significance. This Department has been collecting different types of prices viz. Farm price, Market price, etc. (both Wholesale and Retail). These prices are being widely used for various purposes such as for the preparation of Indices, to provide compensation to Farmers and for tendering consumable articles for Govt. Institutions. Among the Retail prices, the statement of daily prices of fifty essential commodities being collected on daily basis from District Headquarters assume significance, because it is being forwarded daily to the office of the Chief Minister and Minister of Food and Civil Supplies, Minister for Agriculture, ChiefSecretary, Food and civil Supplies Secretary, Planning secretary, Department of Civil supplies, Reserve Bank of India, Consumerfed etc. In addition to the daily prices, weekly prices are also being collected every Friday.

From January 2004 onwards a publication titled "PRICE BULLETIN" is being prepared and published monthly incorporating the Retail prices of main essential commodities under 8 major groups. Group wise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representations.

This publication is being prepared and published by Prices Division.I appreciate the work done by Sri.P.D.SanthoshKumar, Additional Director (Prices). Sri.RajendranKuttikkadu (Assistant Director), Smt.Naseera.M (Research Officer), Sri.SoorajCheruthottathil (Statistical Assistant Grade-I) and all the Price Reporters and Price Supervisors in the Districts for preparing such a worthy publication.

REVIEW ON RETAIL PRICES OF ESSENTIAL COMMODITIES

APRIL- 2022

INTRODUCTION

This bulletin reflects the average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of April 2022. A mixed trend has been seen in the retail prices under report when compared with that of the last months as well as the corresponding month of previous year. Statement showing the monthly average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of April of the previous year 2021, previous month March 2022 and current month of April 2022 along with the percentage of variation over the previous month and the current month of the previous year are included in this report. GroupWise analysis has been made with reference to the current month, the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representation.

1. RICE

Comparison of state average Retail prices of different varieties of Rice

During the month a general increasing trend was observed in the state average retail price of Rice varieties when compared with the prices of the previous month. However when compared with the corresponding month of the previous year a mixed trend observed.

The State average retail prices of Red Matta , White Andhra Vella and Red Chamba increased by 2.36%, 1.39% and 0.53% respectively when compared with the prices of the previous month.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, the state average retail prices of Red Matta and White Andhra Vella increased by 13.05% and 5.59% while that of Red Chamba decreased by 4.50%.

2. PULSES <u>Comparison of state average Retail prices of Pulses.</u>

During the month a general decreasing trend was observed in the state average retail price of Pulses when compared with the prices of the previous month. However when compared with the corresponding month of the previous year a mixed trend observed.


When compared with the prices of previous month, the State average retail prices of all items of Pulses showed a downward trend up to 2.26% except Green gram, Green gram dhal and Peas Dhall. Notable decrease was seen in the price of Red gram (2.26%)

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of all items of pulses showed a mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Red gram (11.71%), Bengal gram Small(7.68%) and Bengal gram Bold(5.36%) when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year.Notable decrease was seen in the price of Green gram 7.42%.

3. OTHER FOOD ITEMS

Comparison of state average Retail prices of other food items.

During the month an increasing trend was observed in the state average retail price of Other food items when compared with the prices of the previous month. However when compared with the corresponding month of the previous year a mixed trend observed.


The State average retail price of all items of Other food items showed an upward trend when compared with the prices of the previous month. Notable increase was seen in the price of Egg(Hens)White Lagon 5.28%. While all other items showed a marginal variations except Milk (Cow's) and Baby Food (amul).

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of Other Food Items showed a mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Baby food (Amul) 10.36%, notable decrease was seen in the price of Egg(Hens)White Lagon 4.78%.

4. OIL AND OILSEEDS

Comparison of state average Retail prices of Oil and oilseeds.

During the month a mixed trend was observed in the state average retail price of Oil and Oil seeds when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.


When compared with the prices of previous month, the State average retail prices of Oil and Oilseeds showed an upward trend up to 8.44% except Coconut without husk and Coconut Oil. Notable increase was seen in the price of Refined oil (8.44%).

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of Oil and Oilseeds showed a mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Gingelly Oil (12.11%), Refined Oil (11%) and Groundnut Oil (7.02%). Notable decrease was seen in the price of Coconut oil 21.86% and coconut without husk (15.68%).

5. SPICES AND CONDIMENTS

Comparison of state Average Retail prices of Spices and Condiments:

During the month a mixed trend was observed in the State average retail price of spices and Condiments when compared with the price of the previous month as well as with the corresponding month of the previous year.


When compared with the price of the previous month. Notable decrease was seen in the price of Garlic (11.61%) and notable increase was seen in the price of Coriander (10.91%) while remaining others items showed marginal variations.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, the state average retail price of all items of Spices and Condiments showed a mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Coriandar (48.19%) and Chillies dry(28.09%), notable decrease was seen in the price of Onion small (33.33%) and Garlic (20.87%).

During the month an increasing trend was observed in the state average retail price of Tubers when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.


When compared with the price of the previous month, the state average retail price of all items of Tubers showed an upward trend up to 15.15%. Notable increase was seen in the price of Coloccassia (15.15%).

Increasing trend was observed in the retail prices of Tubers when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year. Notable increase was seen in the price of Coloccassia (57.46%).and Tapioca Raw(42.97%)

Comparison of state average Retail prices of Vegetables.


During the month a mixed trend was observed in the State average retail price of vegetables when compared with the previous gear an increasing trend was observed.

When compared with the prices of the previous month, the state average retail prices of all items of vegetables showed a mixed trend .Notable increase was seen in the price of Tomato (89.86%), Ladys finger(35.84%) and Snake guard (29.99%).Notable decrease was seen in the price of Onion big (20.86%) and Chillies green (14.55%).

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, the state average retail price of all items of vegetables showed an increasing trend except Ash guard and Brinjal. Notable increase was seen in the price of Tomato (59.54%), Ladys finger(48.19%),Banana green (31.47%) and Snake guard (23.77%),

8. MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

Comparison of state Average Retail prices of miscellaneous items

During the month a marginal fluctuation was observed in the State average retail prices of miscellaneous items when compared with the prices of the previous month but a mixed trend prevails when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of the previous month, the state average retail prices of all items of Miscellaneous items except Crocin showed marginal variations. Notable increase was seen in the price of Toilet Soap-Lux (2.80%)

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous Year the state average retail price of all items except Cement-Sankar, Firewood(Local split) and Mundu mull showed an upward trend up to 16.54%. Notable increase was seen in the price of Toilet Soap -Lux(16.54%), Crocin (12.40%) and Torch Battery (Eveready) (11.49%) respectively. Notable decrease was seen in the price of Cement-Sankar (Ord. Paper Bag) 4.36%.
