#### PREFACE

Price collection is one of the major items of work undertaken by the Department of Economics and Statistics. The importance and usefulness of the information pertaining to the price movements has much significance. This Department has been collecting different types of prices viz. Farm price, Market price, etc. (both Wholesale and Retail). These prices are being widely used for various purposes such as for the preparation of Indices, to provide compensation to Farmers and for tendering consumable articles for Govt. Institutions. Among the Retail prices, the statement of daily prices of fifty essential commodities being collected on daily basis from District Headquarters assume significance, because it is being forwarded daily to the office of the Chief Minister and Minister of Food and Civil Supplies, Minister for Agriculture, Chief Secretary, Food and civil Supplies Secretary, Planning secretary, Department of Civil supplies, Reserve Bank of India, Consumerfed etc. In addition to the daily prices, weekly prices are also being collected every Friday.

From January 2004 onwards a publication titled "PRICE BULLETIN" is being prepared and published monthly incorporating the Retail prices of main essential commodities under 8 major groups. Group wise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representations. These prices are being collected from the market by the Price collectors and supervised by district level Officers

This publication is being prepared and published by Prices Division. I appreciate the work done by Sri.M.G.Haridas (Assistant Director), Smt.Shamju.B.K (Research officer), Sri.Sooraj Cheruthottathil (Statistical Assistant Grade-I) for bringing out such a publication under the guidance of Sri.Sreekumar.B, Additional Director (PRICES)

# **REVIEW ON RETAIL PRICES OF ESSENTIAL COMMODITIES**

# SEPTEMBER- 2022

# **INTRODUCTION**

This bulletin reflects the average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of September 2022. An increasing trend has been seen in the retail prices under report when compared with that of the last months as well as the corresponding month of previous year. Statement showing the monthly average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of September of the previous year 2021, previous month August 2022 and current month of September 2022 along with the percentage of variation over the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year are included in this report. GroupWise analysis has been made with reference to the current month, the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representation.

# 1. RICE

#### **Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Different Varieties of Rice**

During the month an increasing trend was observed in the state average retail price of Rice varieties when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.


The State average retail prices of Red Matta, Red Chamba and White Andhra Vella increased by 5.43 %, 6.06 % and 2.64 % respectively.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, the state average retail prices of Red Matta, Red Chamba and White Andhra Vella increased by 24.93%, 3.75 % and 20.59 % respectively.

# 2. PULSES Comparison of State Average Retail prices of Pulses.

During the month an increasing trend was observed in the state average retail price of Pulses when compared with the prices of the previous month, as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.


When compared with the prices of previous month, an increasing trend was observed in the state average retail price of Pulses. Notable increase was seen in the price of Dhal (Tur) (3.48%), Red gram (2.65%), Peas dhal (1.65%), Bengalgram Bold (1.29%) respectively.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of pulses showed an increasing trend except the prices of Peas dhal. Notable increase was seen in the price of Red gram (15.18 %), Dhal (Tur) (11.49 %), Blackgram Split with husk (9.33 %), Greengram (6.41%), while the prices of Peas dhal decreased by 3.16 %.

### **3. OTHER FOOD ITEMS**

#### Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Other Food Items.

During the month an increasing trend was observed in the state average retail price of Other Food Items when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.


The State average retail price of all items in this group showed an increasing trend except the prices of Tea. Notable increase was seen in the price of Baby food (Amul) (8.26 %), Coffee Powder (5.25 %) when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of Other Food Items showed an increasing trend except the prices of tea and Sugar(OM). Notable increase was seen in the price of Baby food (Amul) (8.26%), Coffee powder (6.17%) and Mutton with bones (2.68%).

# Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Oil and Oilseeds.


During the month a mixed trend was observed in the state average retail price of Oil and Oil seeds when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of previous month, the State average retail prices of Refined oil decreased by 4.70 % and all the other items in this group showed only a marginal variations.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of Oil and Oilseeds showed the mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Groundnut oil (7.60%) and Refined Oil (5.67%), while notable decrease was seen in the price of Coconut oil (17.55%) and Coconut without husk (16.64%).

# 5. SPICES AND CONDIMENTS

# **Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Spices and Condiments:**


During the month an increasing trend was observed in the state average retail price of Spices and Condiments when compared with the price of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

The state average retail price of Spices and Condiments showed an increasing trend except the prices of Garlic when compared with the price of the previous month. Notable increase was seen in the price of Onion Small (28.80 %), the prices of Garlic decreased by 7.26 %. while all the remaining items showed marginal increase.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, the state average retail price of Spices and Condiments showed an increasing trend except the prices of Garlic and Tamarind without seeds Loose. Notable increase was seen in the price of Chillies dry (96.05 %), Coriander (57.64 %), Onion small (44.64 %), Cuminseed (21.26 %), Mustard (14.95 %) and Methy (12.77 %) while notable decrease was seen in the price of Tamarind without seeds Loose (5.65%) and a huge decrease was seen in price of Garlic (-32.81)

# 6. TUBERS

# **Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Tubers**

During the month mixed trend was observed in the state average retail price of Tubers when compared with the prices of the previous month while an increasing trend was noticed in the corresponding month of the previous year.


When compared with the price of the previous month, the state average retail price of Tubers showed a mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Tapioca Raw (6.22 %) while notable decrease was seen in the price of Elephant Yam (9.50%) and Colocasia (7.84 %).

Increasing trend was observed in the retail prices of Tubers when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year. During this period the prices of all items increased significantly. The price of Tapioca Raw have more than doubled from last year (118.45 %). The prices of Colocasia (46.44 %), Potato (41.68 %) and Elephant Yam (27.08%) increased significantly.

# 7. VEGETABLES

## Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Vegetables.


During the month an increasing trend was observed in the State average retail price of Vegetables when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of the previous month, the state average retail prices of Vegetables showed an increasing trend except the prices of Cabbage and Brinjal Notable increase was seen in the price of Tomato (87 %), Cucumber (30.42 %). Pumpkin (23.93%), Ladies finer (19.71%), Bitter gourd (18.99 %), Snake gourd (18.01%) and Ash gourd (13.11 %).

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, the state average retail price of Vegetables showed an increasing trend except the price of Onion Big. Notable increase was seen in the price of Tomato (74.41 %), Plantain green (61.89 %), Banana green (55.91%), Bitter gourd (45.32 %), Cabbage (43.86 %), Ladies finer (43.09 %), Cucumber (41.98 %). Chillies green (37.66 %), Pumpkin (32.47 %), Brinjal (23.78 %), while the price of Onion big decreased by 11.04%.

# 8. MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

## **Comparison of state Average Retail prices of miscellaneous items**

During the month an increasing trend was observed in the state average retail price of this group when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.


When compared with the prices of the previous month, an increasing trend was observed except the prices of Cement and Firewood. Notable increase was seen in the prices of Toilet Soap –Lux (27.90 %), Washing Soda (27.18 %), Toothpaste –Colgate (17.96 %), Torch Battery (Eveready) (12.39 %) and Razor blade (12.32 %). While prices of Cement-Sankar (Ord. Paper Bag) decreased by 6.61 %.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of this group showed an increasing trend except the price of Cement. Notable increase was seen in the price of Toilet Soap –Lux (27.38 %), Washing soda (26.24 %), Toothpaste –Colgate (17.17 %), Razor blade (12.32 %) and Torch Battery (Eveready) (9.98 %) while the price of Cement-Sankar (Ord. Paper Bag) decreased by 3.60 %.
