



### HIGHLIGHTS OF THE RESULTS 1990 CENSUS

- 1. There are 12.22 lakhs enterprises, with 8.25 lakhs in rural sector and 3.97 lakhs in urban sector.
- Ac#tivity-wise distribution shows that 1.10 lakhs are agriculture enterprises and the remaining 11.12 lakhs non-agriculture enterprises.
- The agriculture eneterprises in rural and urban areas are 0.78 lakhs and 0.32 lakhs respectively.
- The non-agriculture enterprises in rural and urban areas are 7.47 lakhs and 3.65 lakhs respectively.
- 5. The number of persons working in all the enterprises is 31.39 lakhs out of which 20.03 lakhs are hired workers.
- The total number of persons working in rural and urban areas are 17.98 lakhs and 13.41 lakhs respectively.
- 7. The total number of females working in enterprises are 7.91 lakhs out of which 6.26 lakhs are bighed workers.
- 8. Out of the 20.03 lakhs hired workers 10.31 lakhs are in rural sector and 9.72 lakhs in urban sector.
- 9. The number of enterprises and employment is maximum in Ernakulam District with 1.34 lakhs and 3.98 lakhs respectively.
- 10. The number of enterprises and employment is minimum in Wayanad with 0.23 lakhs and 0.51 lakhs respectively.
- 11. Kollam District stands first for the number of agriculture enterprises (16684 nos.) female employment (184298 nos) and female hired workers (125686 nos).
- 12. In Kollam District the number of hired females are more than that of hired males.

### ECONOMIC CENSUS OF ENTERPRISES

#### Introduction

Provisional Results of the 1990 Economic Census of Enterprises based on quick manual tabulation have been released for some States and Union Territories by the Central Statistical Organisation.

- 2. According to the provisional results of Kerala, there are a total of 1222268 enterprises having 3138681 persons usually working including 2002609 hired persons. The number of enterprises varies from 134260 in Ernakulam to 23015 in Wayanad. About 63.36% of the enterpreneural activity is carried out without employing any hired person, 12.98% without premises, and 81.57% without power.
- 3. In the State 110251 (9.02%) are agricultural and 1112017 (90.98%) non-agricultural enterprises. Of the agricultural enterprices 70.94% are in rural areas. In the case of non-agricultural enterprises 32.82% are in urban area.
- 4. The economic census was taken during May and June 1990 in the state along with the houselisting operations of the Population Census. The Economic Census ascertained the structure, nature of activities and number of persons usually working in all the enterprises. The Agricultural enterprises included livestock production, agricultural services, hunting, trapping and game propagation, forestry and logging and fishing but did not cover crop production and planations. The non-agricultural enterprises included mining and quarrying, manufacturing, electricity, gas and water, trade, hotels and restaurants, construction, transport and services. The census covered enterprises employing atleast one hired worker on a regular basis and also own-account enterprises not employing any hired worker.
- 5. The Central Statistical Organisation in co-operation with the State Directorate of Economics and Statistics was responsible for the planning and technical guidance of the economic census operations. The Registrar General and Census Commissioner of India and the State Directors of Census Operations were responsible for the organisation and co-ordination of field operations.
- 6. A background note and a set of statements giving the provisional results for different districts of the state are attached.

#### EACKGROUND-NOTE

The Central Statistical Organisation launched a scheme of Economic Census & Surveys in 1976 to fill data gaps in the unorganised sectors of non-agricultural economy. The scheme invisaged organising periodically countrywide census of economic activities followed by detailed sample surveys of unorganised segments of non-agricultural economy. The economic census was aimed at providing basic information on distribution of non-agricultural enterprises and follow-up surveys for collection of detailed information about the structure of enterprises, investments, input, output, employment etc. of the enterprises.

- 2. The first economic census covering non-agricultural establishemts (enterprises engaging atleast one hired worker on a fairly regular basis) was carried out in 1977. This was followed by two sample surveys - one in 19788-79 relating to unorganised manufacturing and the second in 1979-80 devoted to trade, transport, hotels and restraurants, storage and ware housing and services. Taking advantage of the field agency deployed by the Registrar General of India (RGI) for houselisting operations, the second economic census was conducted in 1980 along with houselisting operations of 1981 Population Census with increased scope and coverage. It covered all enterprises (establishments and own account enterprises) in the non-agricultural sector and agricultural sector excluding those engaged in crop production and plantation. Based on the frame thrown up by this Census, three follow-up surveys were designed and carried out, one in 1983-84 on hotels and restaurantsm, transport, storage and warehousing and services, second in 1984-85 on unorganised manufacturing and third in 1985-86 on wholesale and retail trade.
- 3. The third Economic Census although approved by the Planning Commission for being conducted in 1986 could be carried out to financial constrains. In order to continue the follow-up survey programme, the frame of 1980 Economic Census was updated during 1987-88 in some of the urban areas having problems of indentification of enumeration blocks and changes due to rapid industrialisation. On the basis of the updated frame a survey on hotels & restaurants and transport was conducted in 1988-89. The second on unorganised manufacturing was carried out in 1989-90. The third survey on wholesale and retail has been launched during 1990-91: The fourth survey on services sector under this series will be conducted during 1991-92.

#### Need for Third Economic Census

4. The main objective of an economic census is to provide a complete frame for detailed enquiries intended, to cover information on nature of activity, employment, emoluments, expenditure, receipts, inventory of fixed assets etc. of the enterpreises to be covered on a sample basis. In view of the rapid changes in the structure of unorganised segments of non-agricultural sectors due to high mobility and mortality of the small units and also in view of the births of new units, it is very necessary to update the frame frequently. The five years interval is considered to be minimum essential for conducting the census periodically.

5. As the frame based on second economic census as also the updated frame of 1987-88 were no longer useful, a new frame was considered very necessary for further follow-up surveys. The third economic census was, therefore, immediately required. For case of operational conveniences and cost of effectiveness, it was decided to synchronise the Third Economic Census with the houselisting operations of the Population Census 1991.

### Scope and Coverage

6. Under the Third Economic Census a complete enumeration of enterpreneurial activities other than crop production and plantation in rural and urban areas of the country was carried out. The formation was collected on location of enterprises, description of activity of the enterprise, nature of operations, type of ownership, social group of owner, power/fuel used for the activity and the number of hired persons usually working in the enterprises. The need for essential minimum items, simplicity and experience gained in the First and Second Economic Censuses have been taken into account in designing the schedules for the collection of various items of information in 1990 Economic Census.

### Definition of an Enterprise

7. For the purpose of Economic Census, an enterprise is defined as an undertaking engaged in production and/or distribution of goods and/or services not for the sole purpose of own consumption. An agricultural enterprise is defined as one engaged in livetock production, agricultural services, hunting, trapping and game propagation, forestry and logging and fishing (corresponding to the Divisions 02, 03, 04, 05 and 06 of National Industrial Classification 1987. Enterprises engaged in activities pertaining to agricultural production and plantation (Division 00 and 01 of NIC of 1987) were not covered under the census. Enterprises engaged in all other activities are termed as non-agricultural enterprises. Enterprises engaged in economic activities with the assistance of atleast one hired worker on a fairly regular basis are defined as establishments. The enterprises operated with the help of house-hold labour only are termed as own account enterprises.

### Planning for the Census

8. A good deal of spade work had to be carried out for organising the census. A Technical Advisory Group (TAG) under the Chairmanship of the Special Secretary, Planning Commission and experts both from Central and State Governments and non-governments, Research and User organisation was constituted to provide all technical guidance for the Third Economic Census. The TAG had two meetings and finalised the scope, coverage and concepts. It also finalised the enterprise list form canvased during the house listing operations for the Population Census 1991 and the tabulation plan of 1990 Economic Census.

#### Operations

9. The Economic Census was taken up in different Territories except J&K along with the house listing operations during the period April to September, 1990. In the house listing operations, after numbering the building and the houses, information on the purpose for which the census house is used and whether the household is engaged in any entrepreneurial activity outside the census house and without premises, was also collected by the enumerator. The part-time services of locally drawn personnel such as school teachers, village level workers, municipal workers and other town level workers who were appointed as enumerators, were used for the listing operations. local officials of slightly senior levels were appointed as sueprvisors. The Registrar General and Census Commissioner of India and the State Directors of Census Operations were responsible for the organisation and co-ordination of the field operations. The overall responsibility for technical guidance and tabulation of the Economic Census data rests with the Central Statistical organisation in co-operation with the Directorate of Economics and Statistics in the State. The operations of Economic Census and houselisting were fully co-ordinated between the Directors of Census Operations the State Directors of Economics and Statistics and thier Officers and staff. The District Statistical Officers were designated as Additional District Census Officers. common intesive training programme was organisZed both for houselisting of the Population Census as well as Enterprise List of Economic Census at State, district and lower levels. The technical and other aspects of organisation of the Census were also reviewed at the meetings of State Directors of Economics and Statistics and at the conferences of Directors of Census Operations.

### Provisional Results

10. Arrangements were made for quick tabulation of important items in he Enterprise List by the Enumerators themselves as part of the Census Operations. For this purpose, an Enterprise list Abstract was prescribed to be filled up immediately after the field work in an Enumerator's block was completed. Further aggregations at Tehsil and district levels were done by the State Statistical staff to provide provisional results on items such as the total anad hired employment in these enterprises, and selected characteristics of the enterprises.

## Comparison with 1980 Census

The Quick Manual Tabulation results of the Third Economic Census 1990 held recently reveals that there are 12.22 lakhs enterprises in the State as against 8.72 lakhs in 1980. The percentage of increase of enterprises thus worksout to 40.18 over a decade. The total number of persons working in these enterprises rose to 31.39 lakhs from 24.82 lakhs. The average persons working per enterprises has slightly decreased from 2.81 in 1980 to 2.57 in 1990. Further, when the decadical increase of enterprises is 40.18%, the increase of employment worked only 28.03% over the 1980 figures.

## Comparison with 1977 Census

In 1977 a country-wide Economic Census was conducted for the first time, in which the details regarding establishments (a unit run with at least one hired worker) in the non-agriculture sector alone were collected. Further, units run on a fairly regular basis were given stress in this Census. According to the 1977 Census the details of establishments, persons employed etc are as follows.

Apart from this it has been revealed that 79.9% of the establishments were in private sector. The subsequent Economic Census conducted during 1980 and 1990 were based on broad frame and including agriculture as well as on account enterprises. As such it is needless to compare the results of 1977 census figures with that of 1980 and 1990.

The following statements show a comparative study of the number of enterprises, persons working etc. for the year 1980 and 1990.
